

Get In A Quick 10

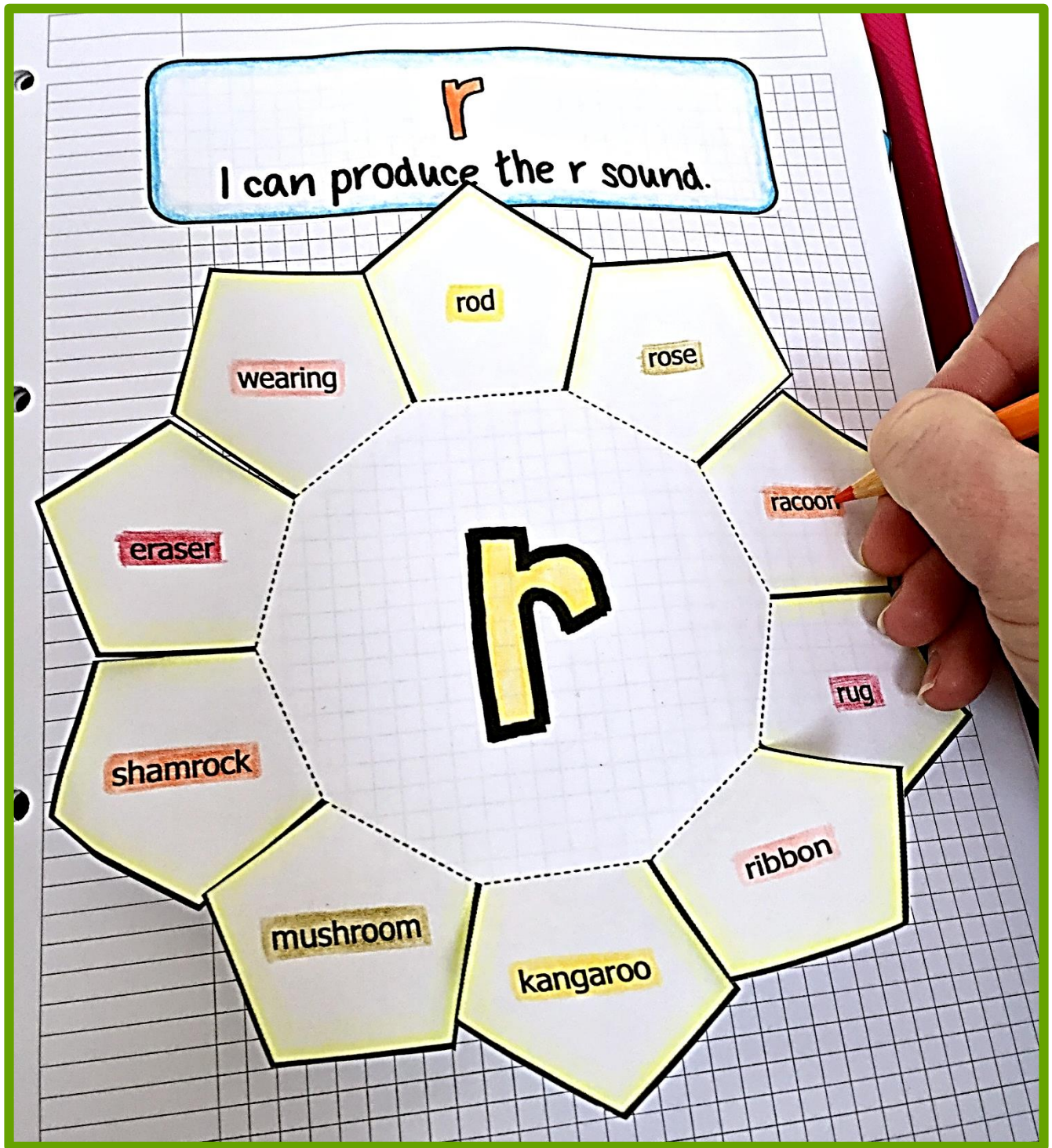


This quick activity is a fun and interactive way to elicit multiple repetitions of target articulation sounds. Each grid houses 10 spaces to make tracking Speech progress a breeze.

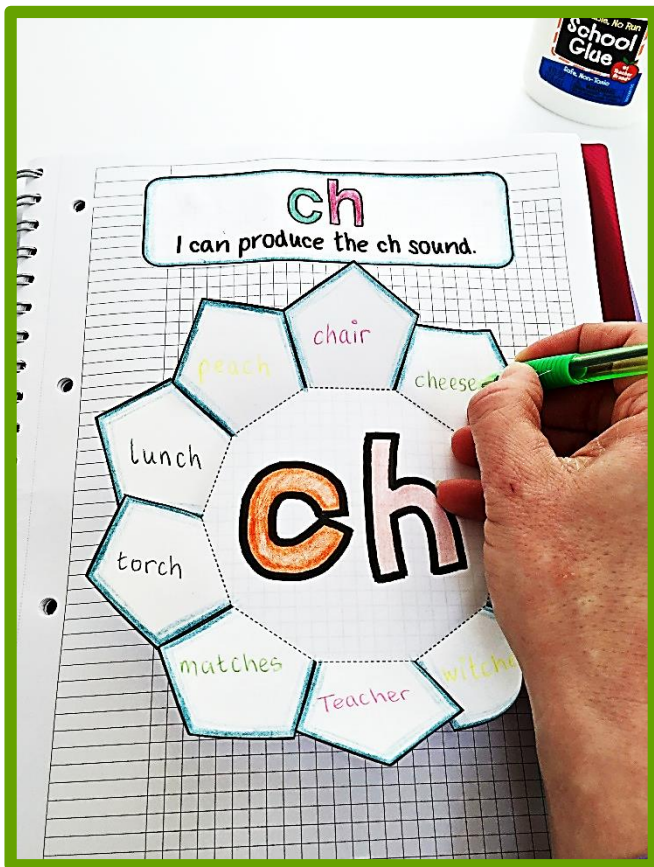
There are several ways that you can use these templates.

To assemble your project, cut along the solid lines and glue down the center section only into a notebook. Then fold the flaps inward to create a flower petal effect as your student practices.
