


The following templates can be used as simple lift-the-flap activities to practice single articulation sounds.

However, they will also work at the phrase level. i.e. "can under butterfly" or "The watering can is under the butterfly."






































































In this section you will find "double – door" flap templates. Make the cut up through the center of the image last, after it has been stuck into the notebook.




