

Make Your Own Glue Sponges

Gather your supplies:

Plastic containers
with lids



PVA Glue

Sponges



either thick sponges
(without scrub side)



...or sponge cloths built
up in layers

Make Your Own Glue Sponges

1. Fill your plastic container with sponge. If using a thicker sponge, you may need to use more than 1 sponge per box. Cut them to fit together snugly into the box.



If using thinner sponge cloths, you will need to cut your sponges to fit best and then layer them inside your box



Make Your Own Glue Sponges

2. Add the glue to your box.

For an average 'sandwich size' box, you will need to use approximately one 4oz bottle of glue per sponge container.



3. Fasten the lids onto your containers and allow the glue to soak in. Your glue sponges will be ready to use in hours.

Glue sticks tend to dry out and don't stick as well as liquid glue. Making glue dots from a bottle can be hard to control for kids with motor difficulties. Too much glue and the pages will stick together...

Making your own glue sponges will save mess and hassle in your speech room, and they last for months!
