Practice target vowel /i/ with pitch variations as your student “comes to the rescue” with the various Emergency vehicles in this town map activity.

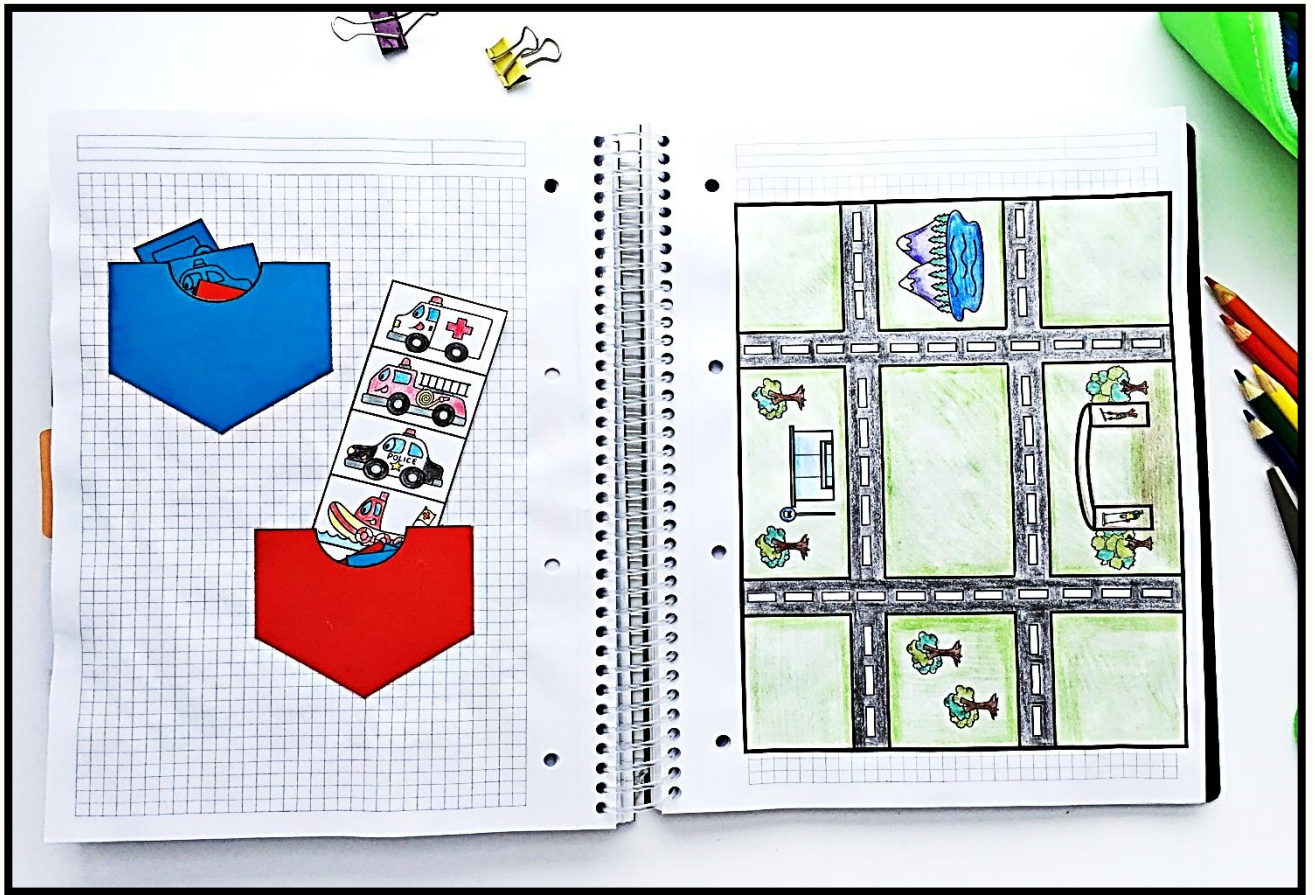
Construct the notebook page as pictured to create an engaging town map.

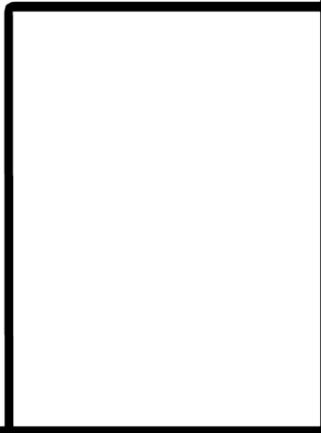
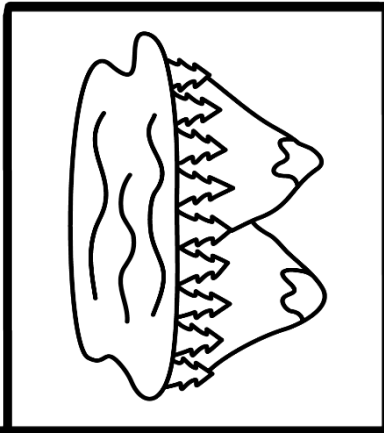
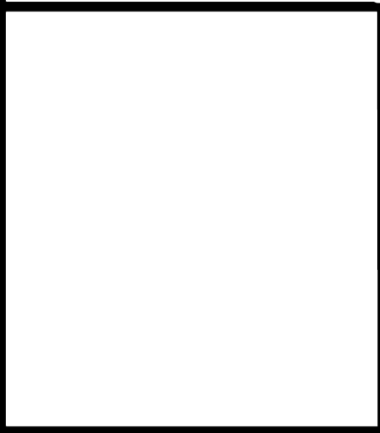
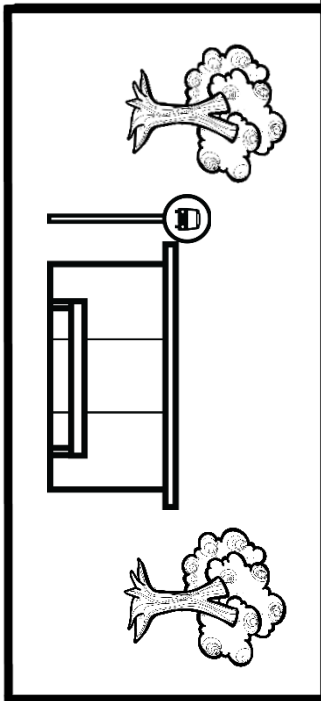
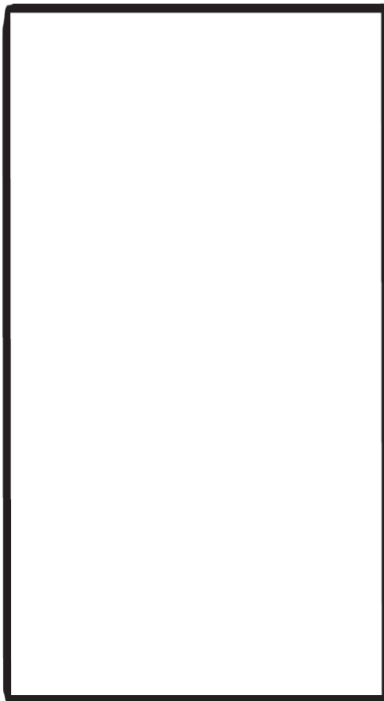
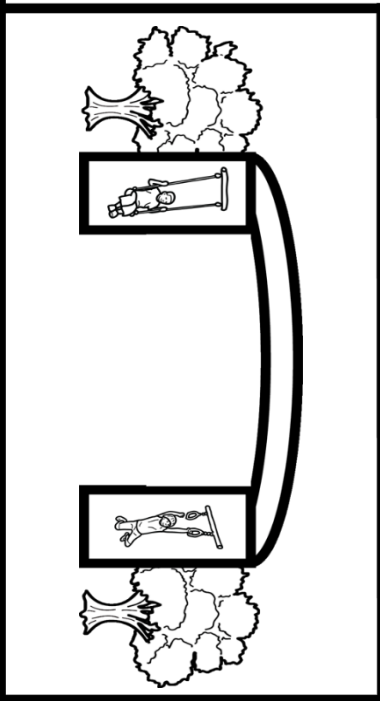
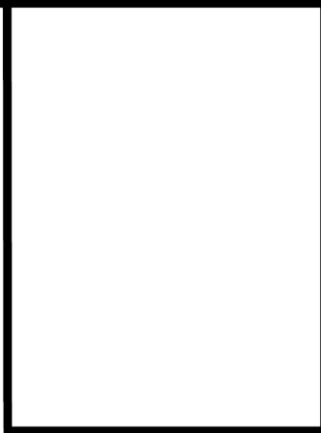
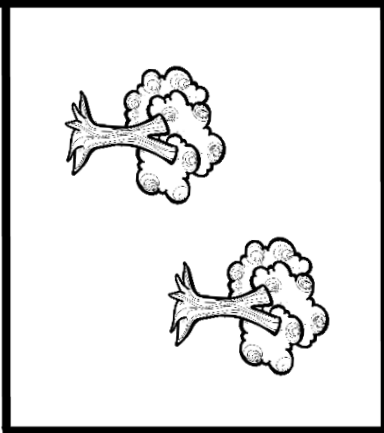
Cue your student to practice “ee” for a siren sound.

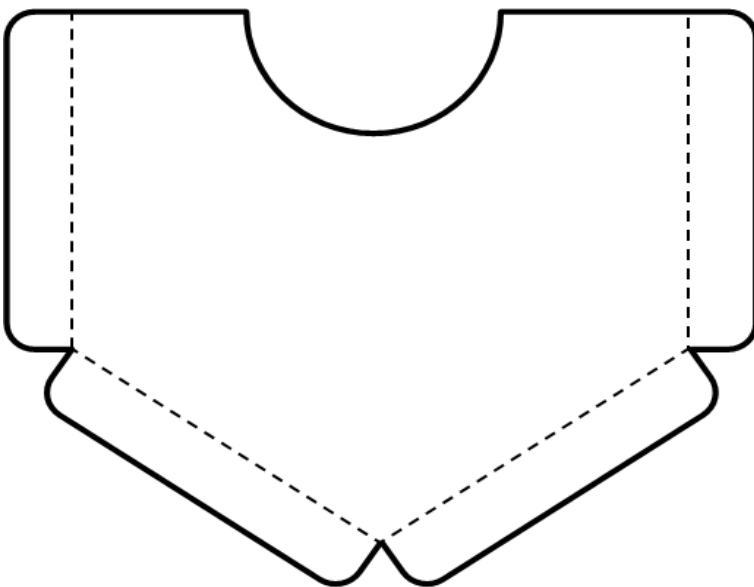
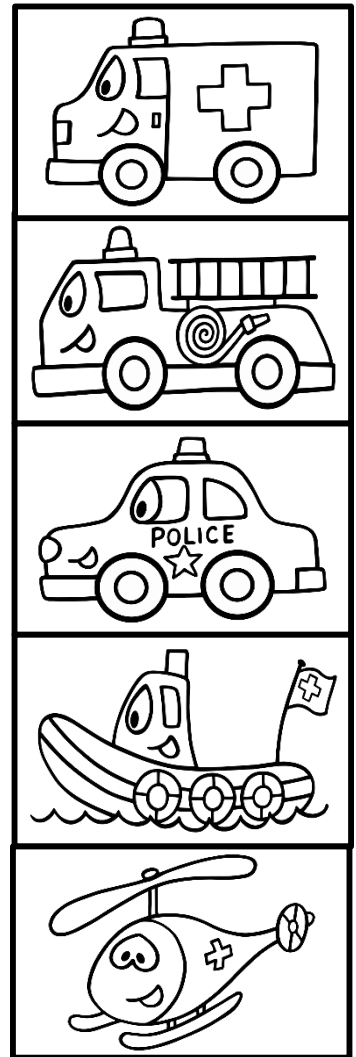
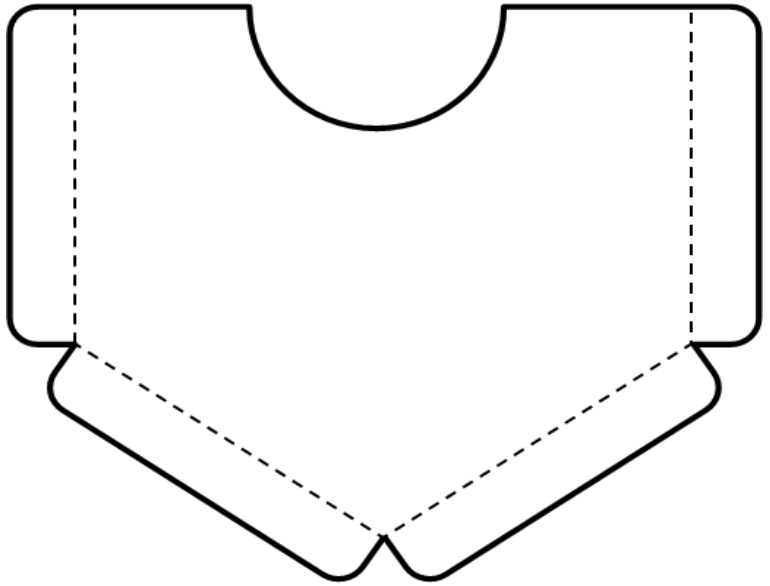
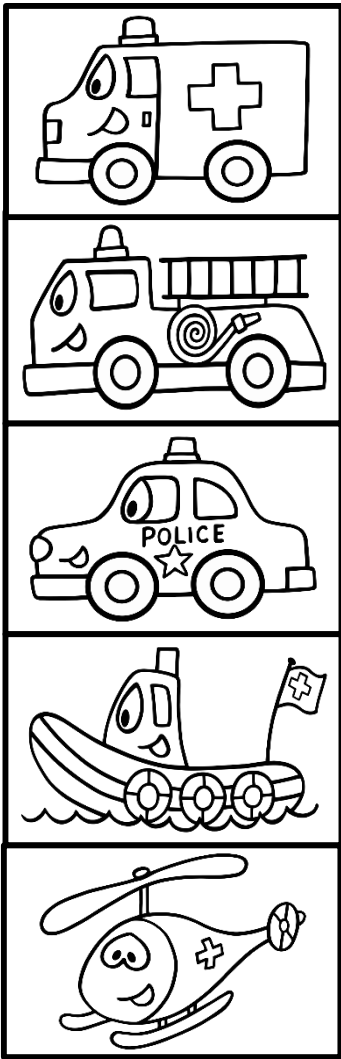
Place the 5 emergency vehicle cut outs in front of the student.

Encourage pretend play scenarios by narrating for the student. For example you could say, “Oh no, there is a fire at the park. Here comes the fire truck.”

Your student selects the correct vehicle and rushes to the rescue on the map whilst practicing /i/ with varied tone.
