

Target /eɪ/ and /ɔ/

Off to the Races!

Practice target vowel /eɪ/ to cheer as your students “avoid the obstacles” with the racecar in this crazy racetrack activity.

Construct the notebook page as pictured to create racetrack.

Cue your student to practice “ay” for a cheer sound or “aw” for a disappointed sound.

Place the racecar cut outs in front of the student. (You may choose to use small toy cars if you have them available.)

Encourage pretend play scenarios by narrating for the student. For example you could say, “He’s crossed the finish line, let’s cheer! Ayyy!” or “Oh, no! He’s hit a pothole! Awwww!”

Your student places their racecar and zooms around the track whilst practicing /eɪ/ and /ɔ/as obstacles are avoided.
