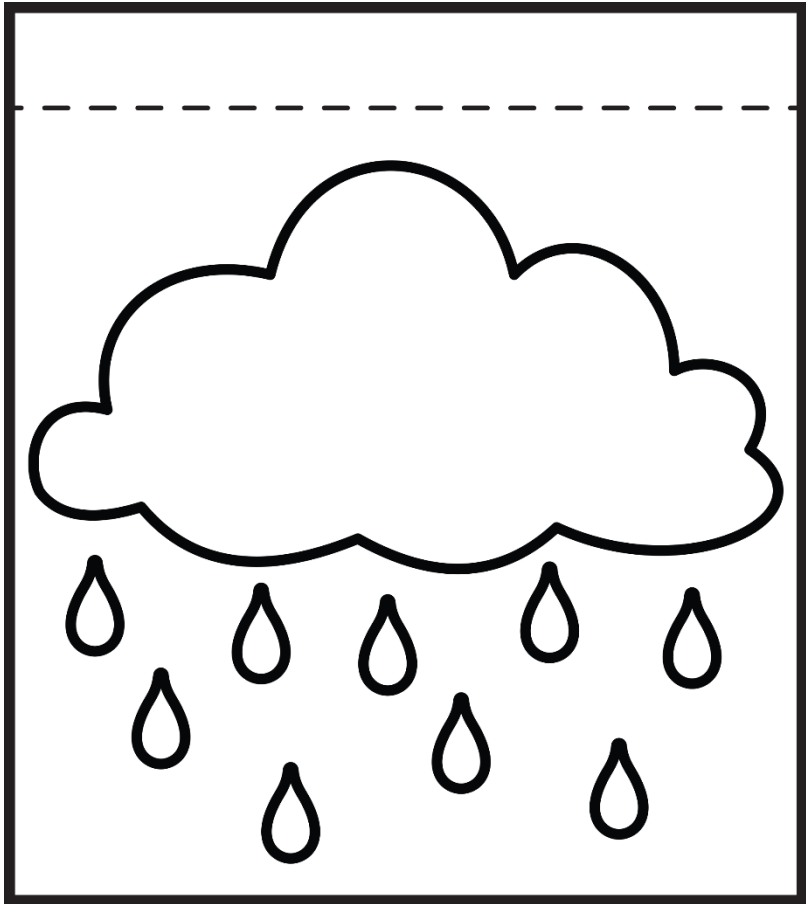
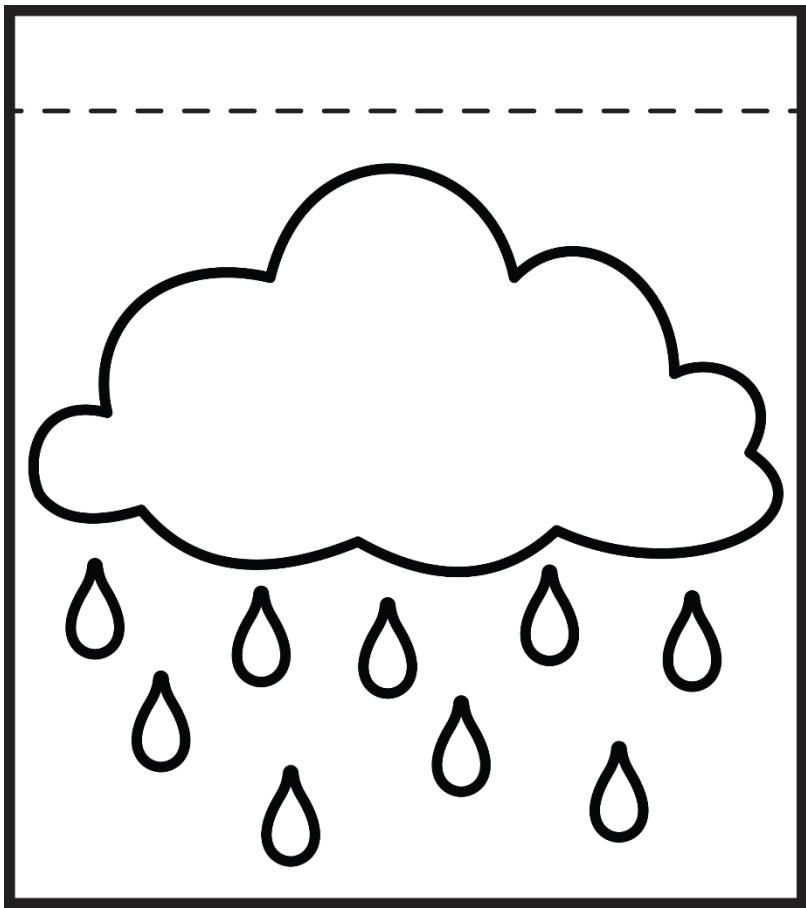


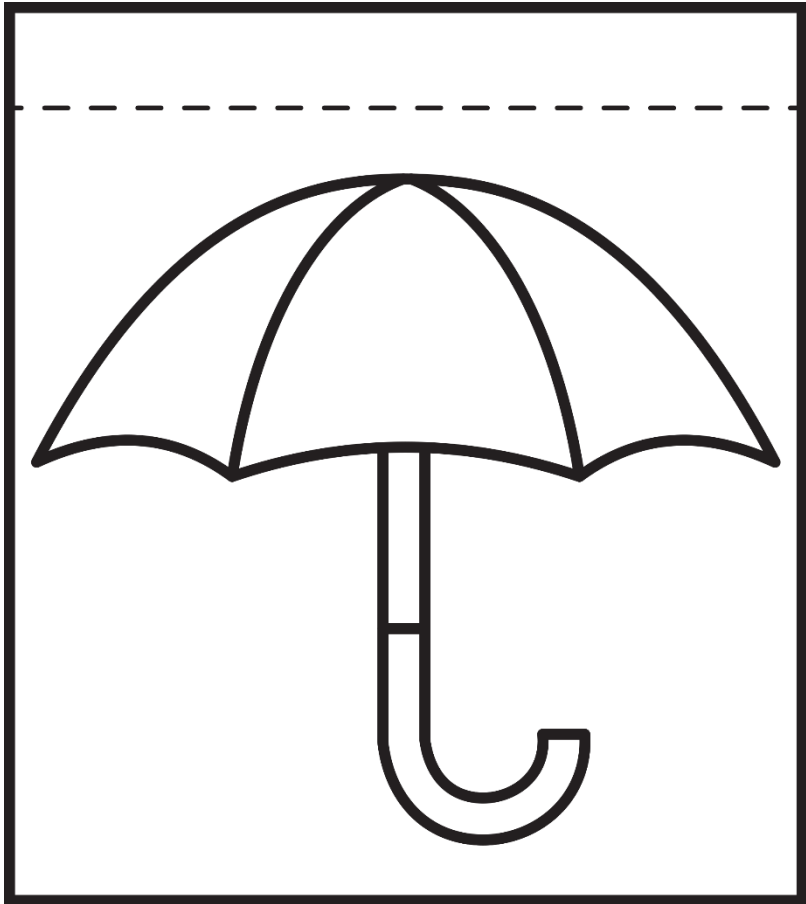
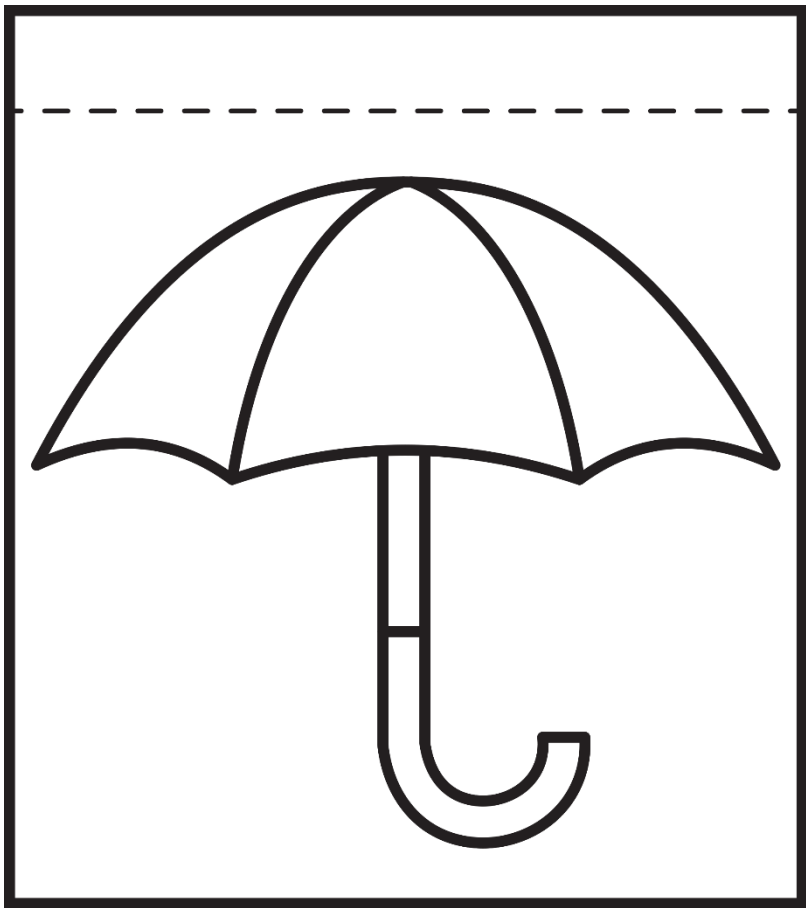














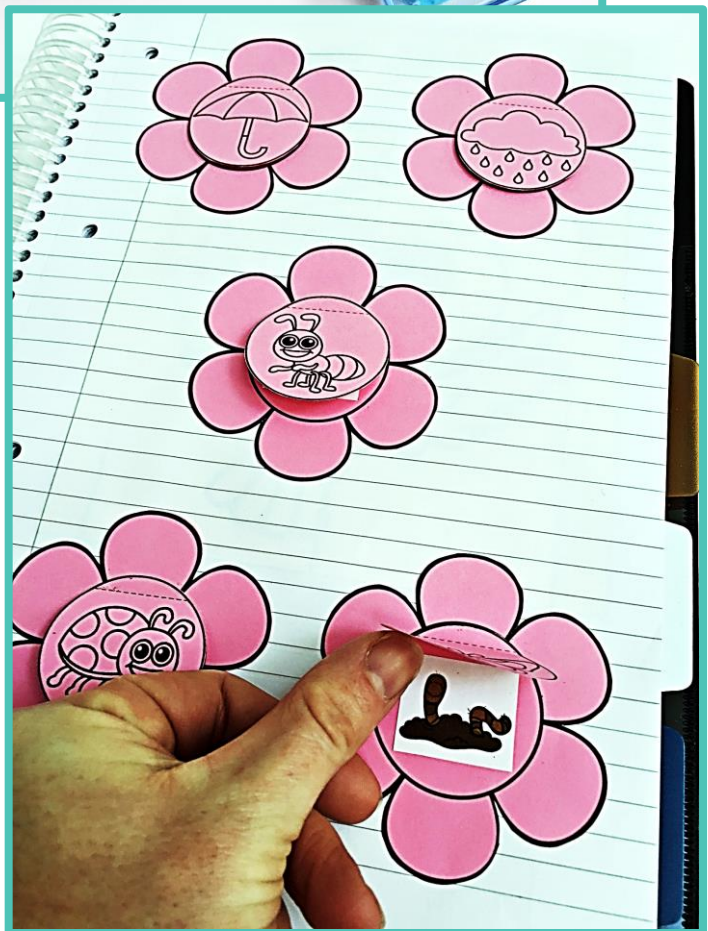
Print the following page on colorful cardstock.

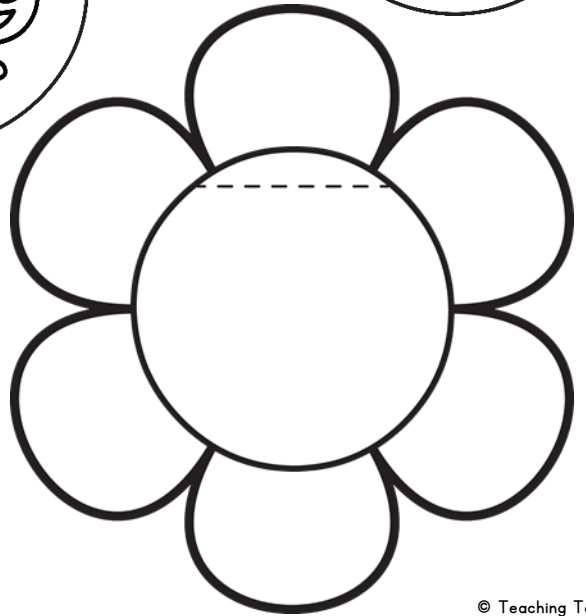
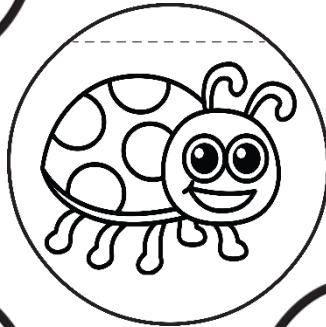
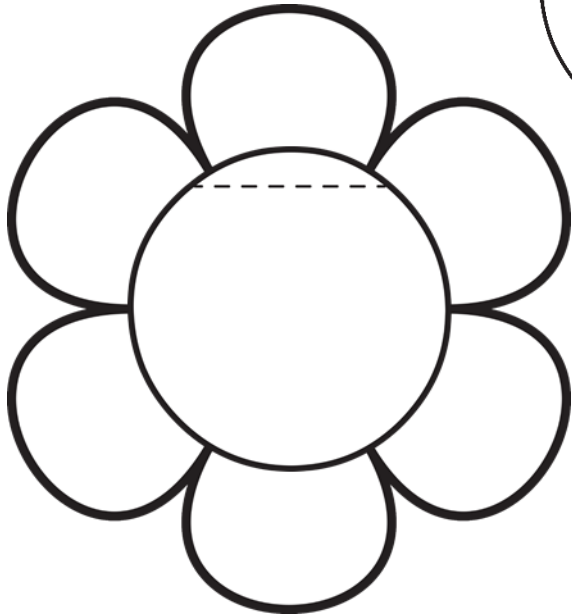
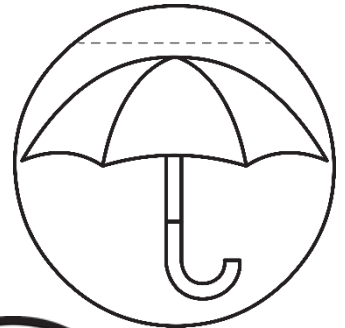
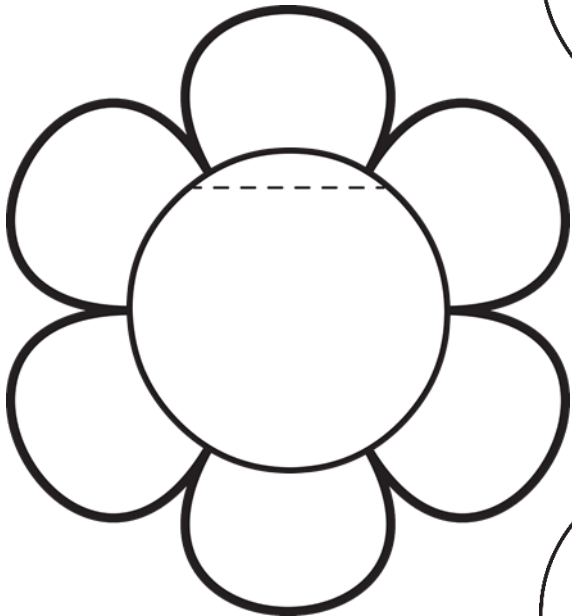
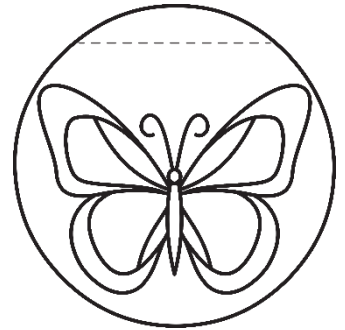
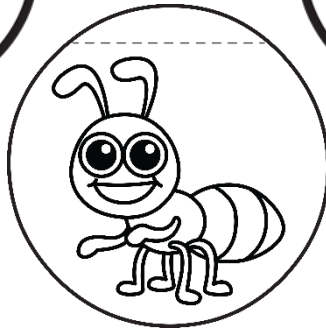
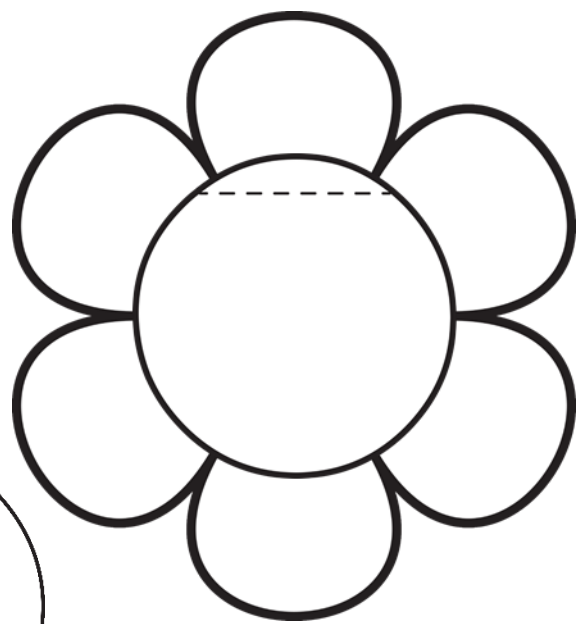
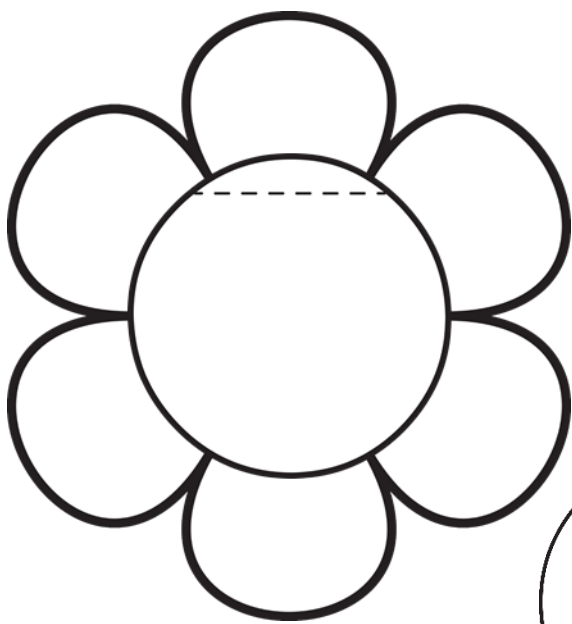
Glue the flowers flat into your notebook.

Now you're ready to practice!







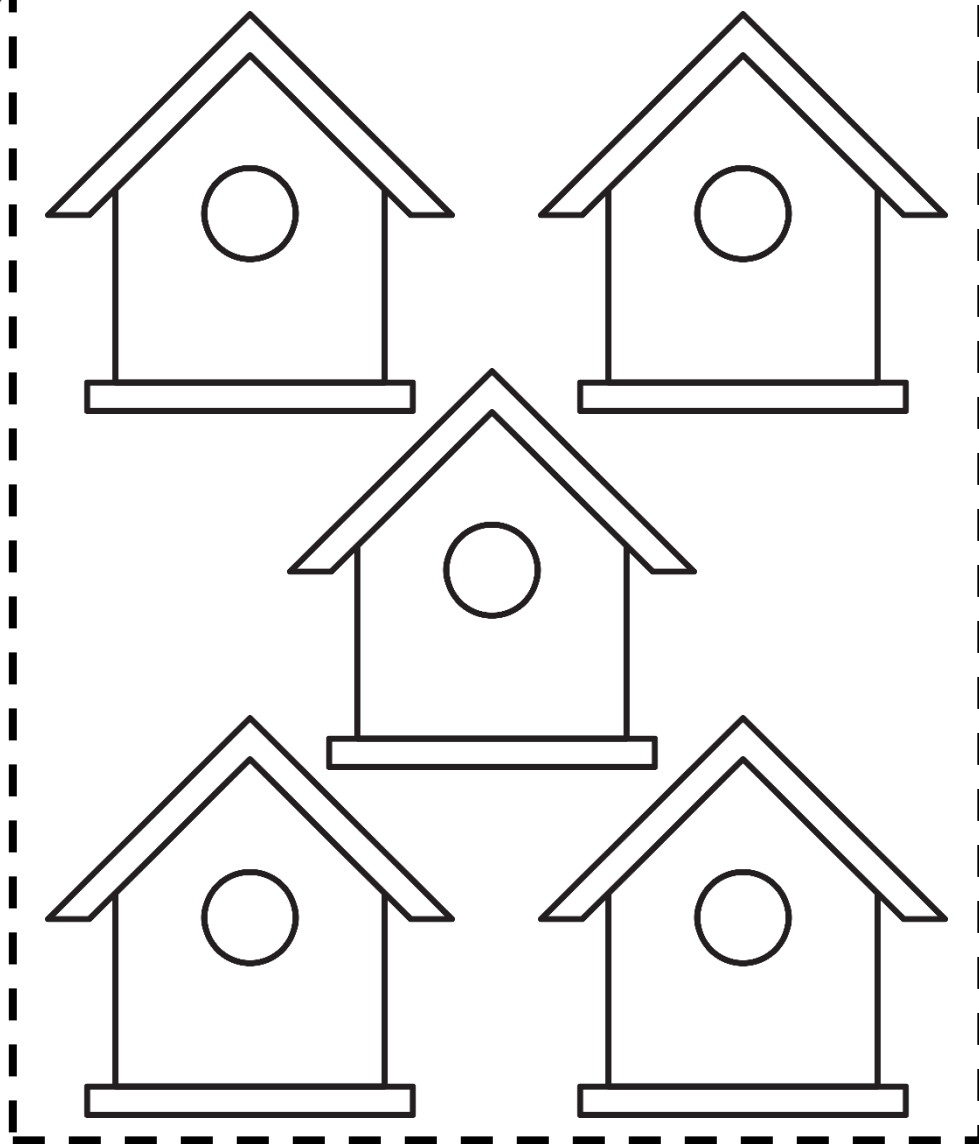
In this section you will find a “double - door” flap template. Make the cut up through the center of the image last, after it has been stuck into the notebook.

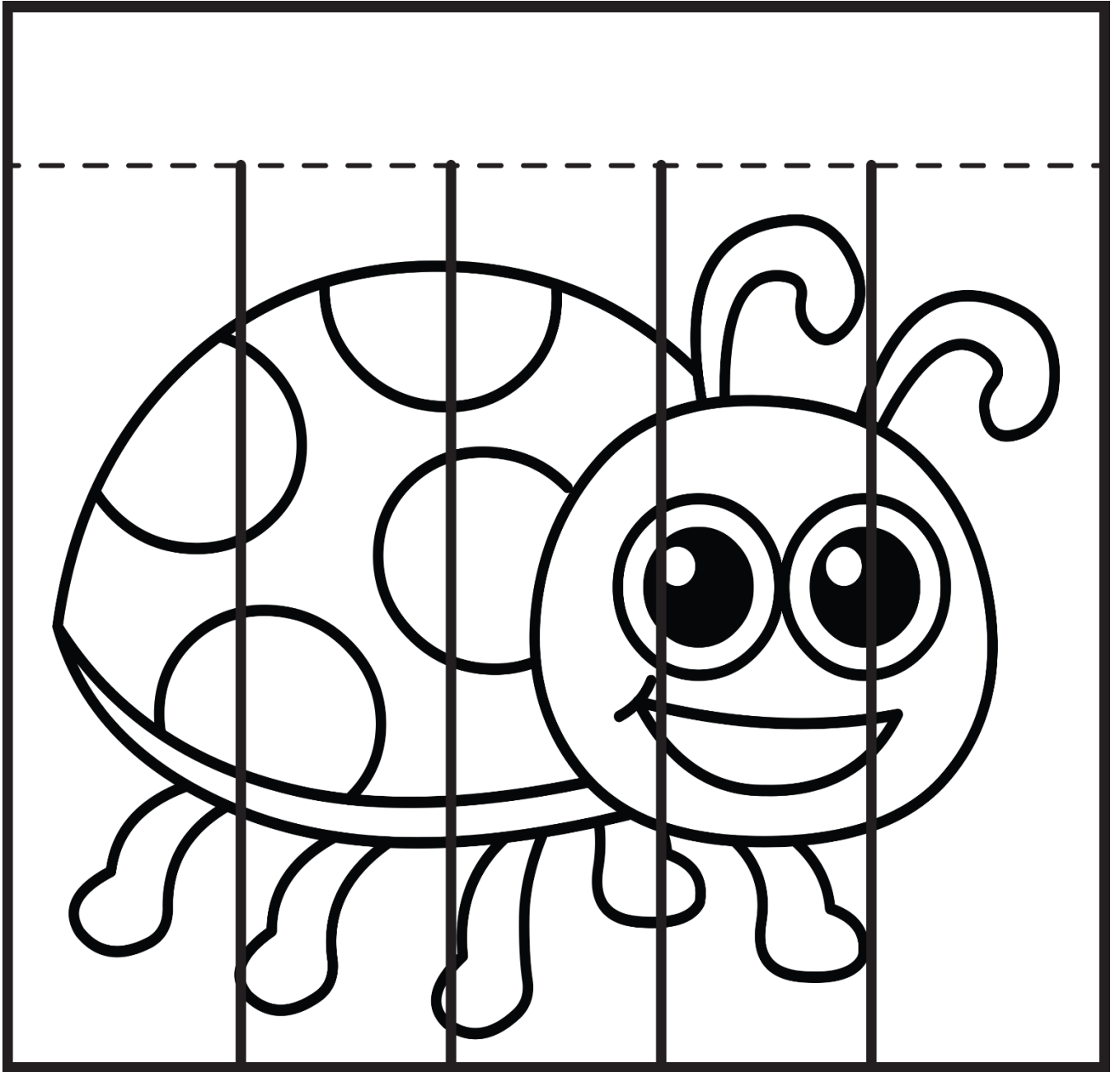


The templates in this section are sized to neatly house **5** mini-images under each flap. Use them as revision activities to cover all of the sounds you've been working on.

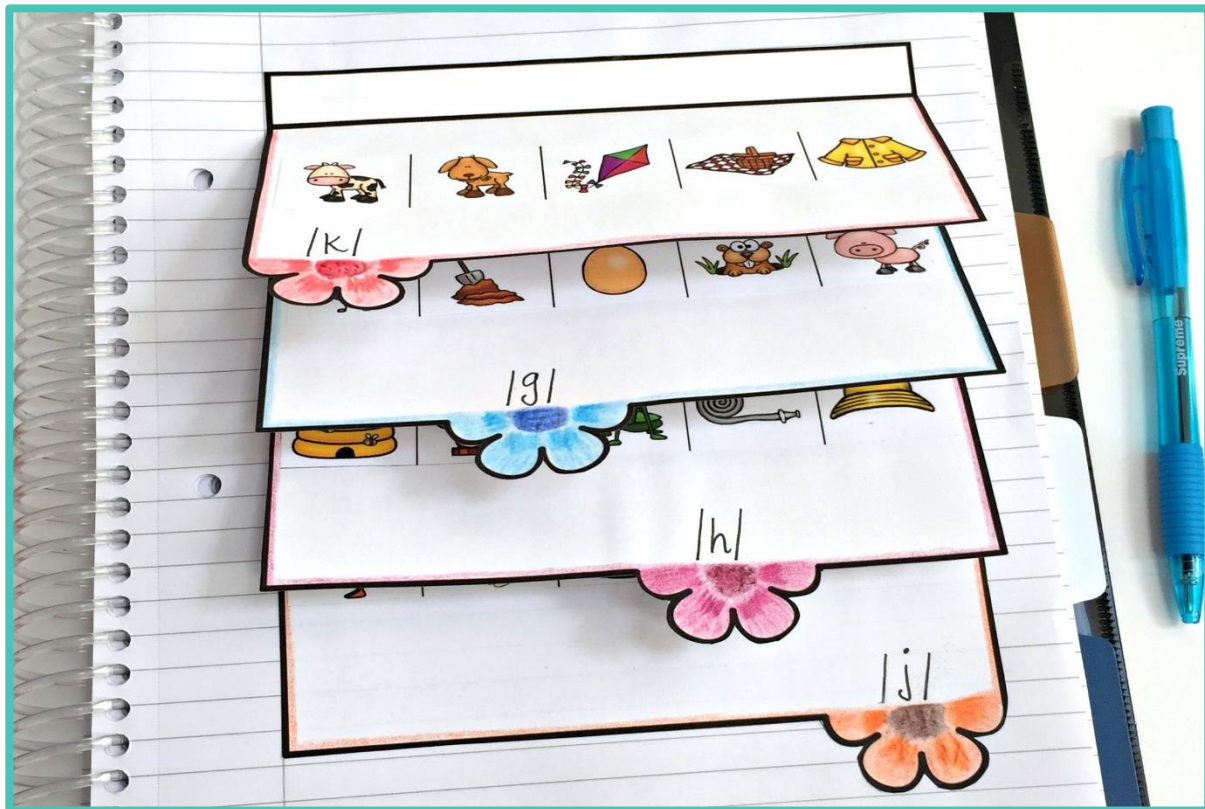
