

## **Using the Editable PDF** \* you will need the <u>FREE Adobe Acrobat Reader</u> to edit this file

- 1. Clicking on the image icon on each page will bring up a "Select Image" dialog box.
- 2. Click "Browse" and navigate to the place on your computer where your images are saved. Select an image and click "OK" to easily insert your students' photographs into the booklet.
- 3. Click where it says "Insert Your Text Here" to add the student's name to the cover. Repeat this step on each page with a short description of the image shown.

**SLP Tip:** If possible, take the photos you intend to use in a portrait orientation (up & down photo style) vs landscape orientation (left & right photo style) so your student's favorite things appear larger on each page. You can use the provided take-home sheet to explain this if you plan to ask caregivers to capture the photographs.

## Assembly Instructions

- Cut out each shape and layer the pages by number with 1 being the first page you lay down, then 2 on top, etc.
- 2. Add the cover with your student's name and picture on top and staple the book together.
- 3. You can also use this flipbook as a notebook activity by gluing page 1 down first. Then layer the others on top securing with glue as you go.
