

## Using the Editable PDF \* you will need the [FREE Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) to edit this file

1. Clicking on the image icon on each page will bring up a "Select Image" dialog box.
2. Click "Browse" and navigate to the place on your computer where your images are saved. Select an image and click "OK" to easily insert your students' photographs into the booklet.
3. Click where it says "Insert Your Text Here" to add the student's name to the cover. Repeat this step on each page with a short description of the image shown.

**SLP Tip:** Photos are best printed on white cardstock rather than colored. The images seem to disappear into colored paper.



# Folding Your Lapbook

1. Use one 8" x 10" File Folder
2. Open and flatten the file folder.
3. Find the center of the right side of folder, and fold lengthwise on center line of right side.
4. Find the center of the left side of folder, and fold lengthwise on center line of left side. Sides should meet.

1. Glue Front Cover Right Flap Base Page flat onto the notebook.
2. Fold at the dotted line on the flaps found on this page.
3. Apply glue to the back side above the dotted line & secure one on top of the other on the indicated markers on base page. Secure the "Notes From My SLP" page last.
4. Use this page to send home special notes of encouragement to your student!



# "My Favorite..." Flip Book Assembly Instructions:

1. Cut out each page and glue layer 1 into your notebook.
2. Taking care to align the top of each page, layer the pages by their numbers with 1 being the first page, then 2 on top, etc.
3. Select and cut out your character topper. Fold along the dotted line.





# “My Favorite...” Flip Book Assembly Instructions:

4. Apply glue above the fold on the back side of the character topper and align with the top of your layered pages using the dotted line as a guide. Stick into notebook to create the top page of your flip book.
5. Insert your student's photo inside of the frame and secure into notebook above the flip book.
6. This activity also works great as a take-home review flipbook. Print the pages on durable cardstock and cut. Using the dotted lines as a guide, layer the pages & staple to create your booklet.

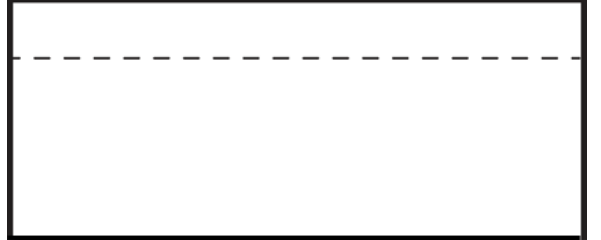
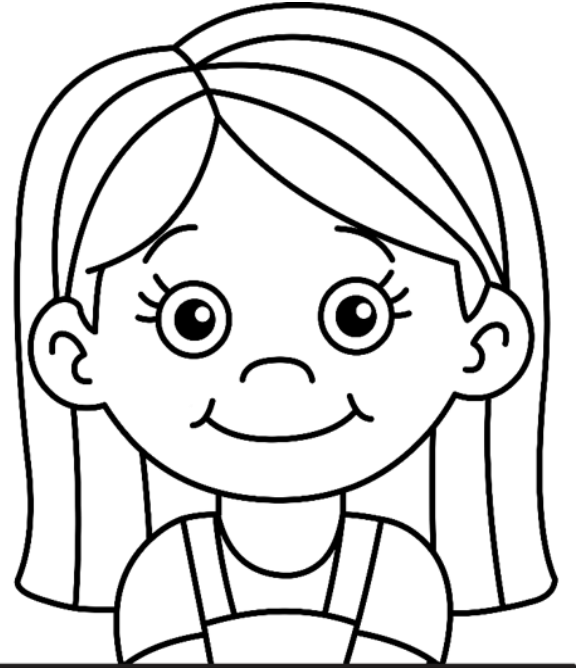
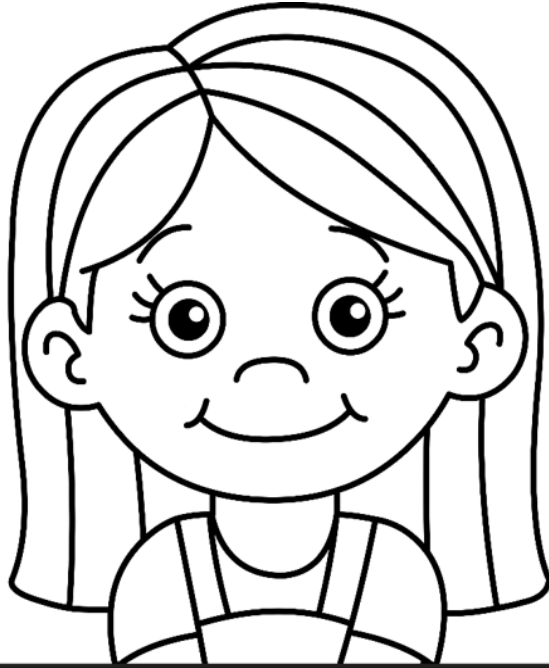
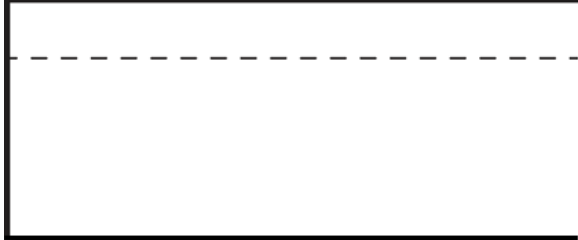
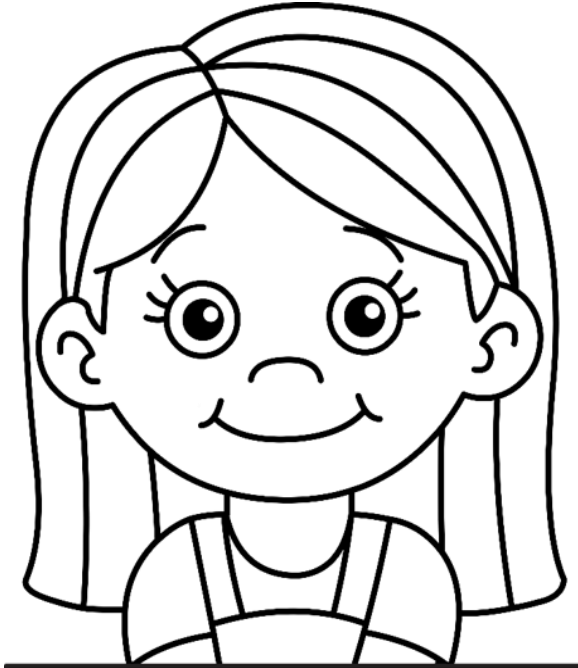


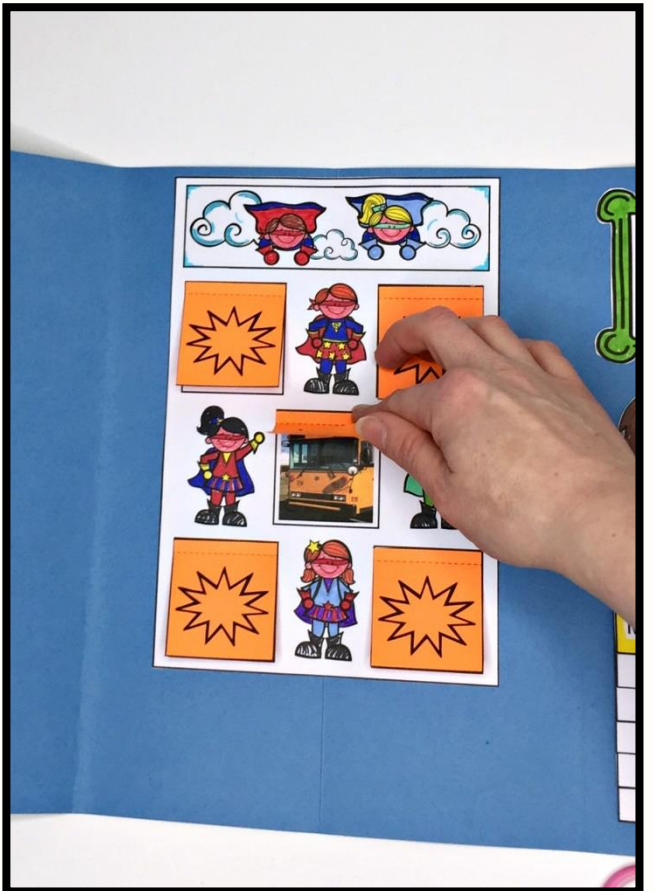












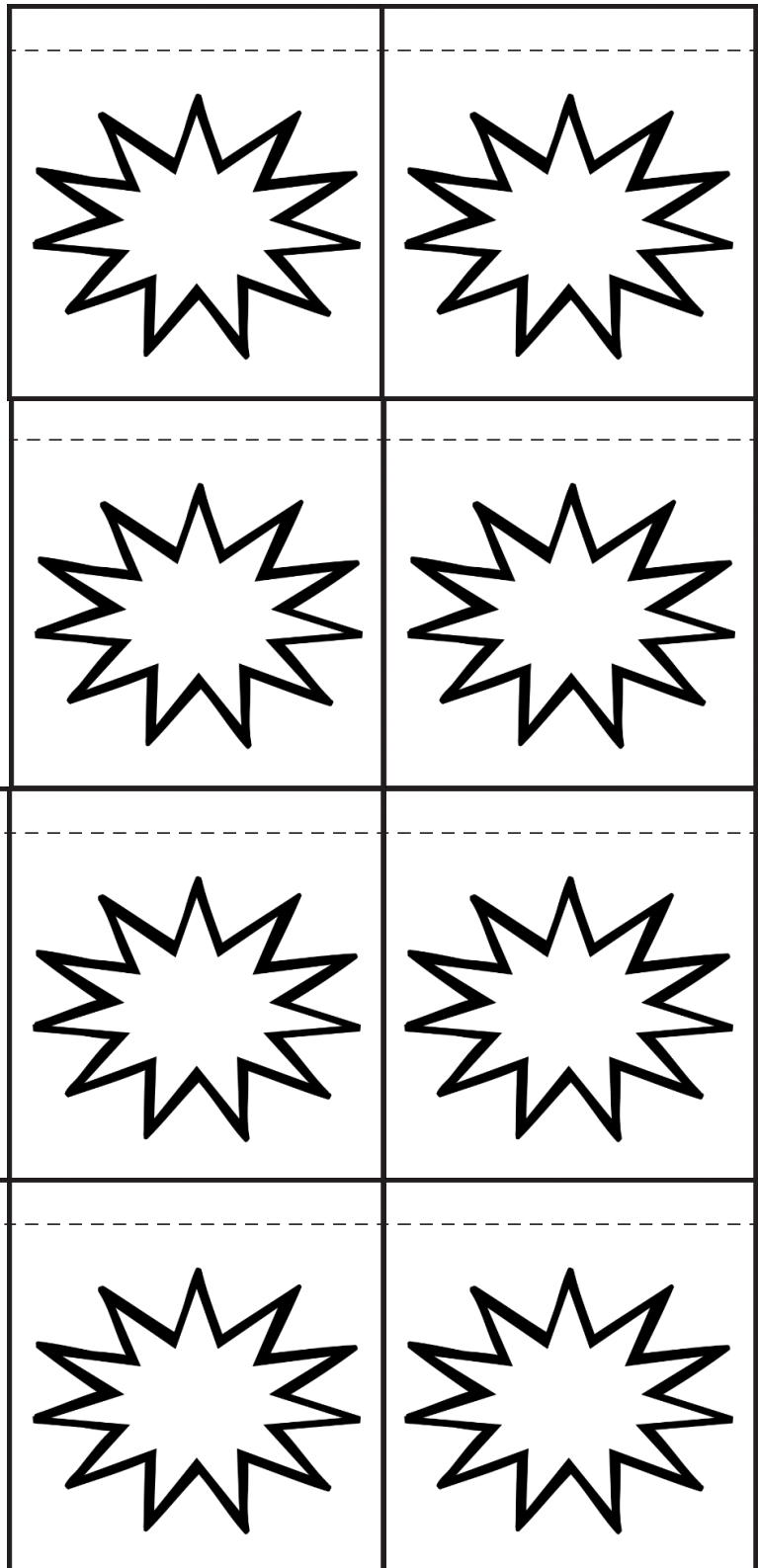


# "My Super Words" Flaps

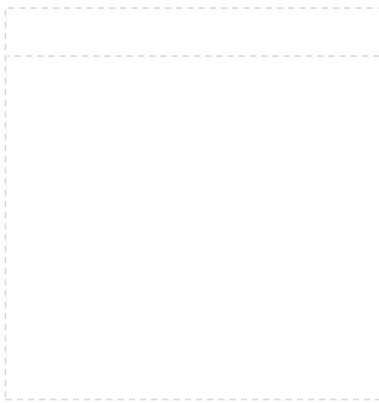
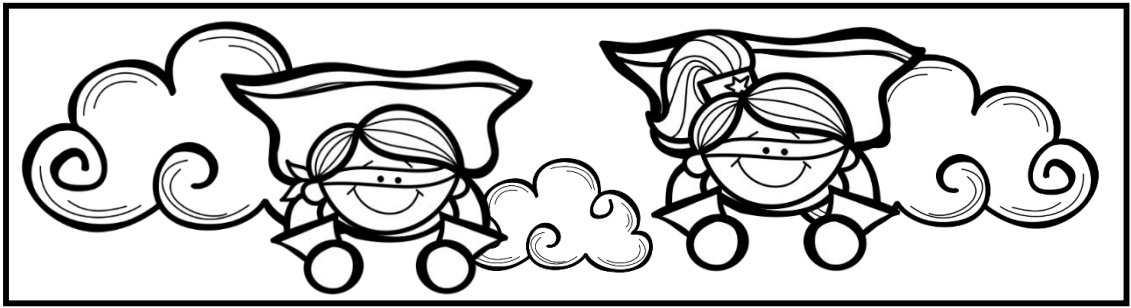
1. Glue "My Super Words" Base Page - with flaps flat into the notebook.

2. Fold at the dotted line on the flaps found on this page.

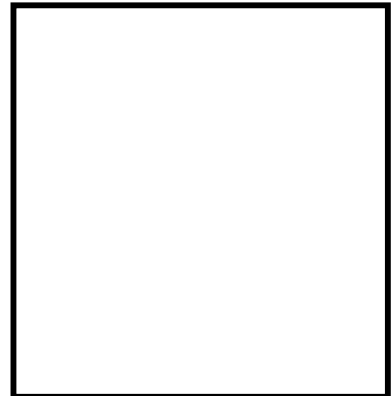
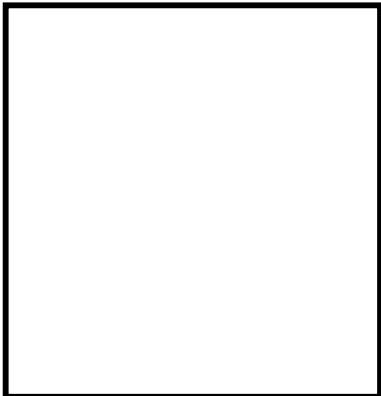
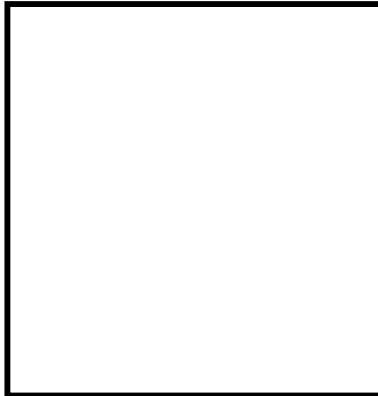
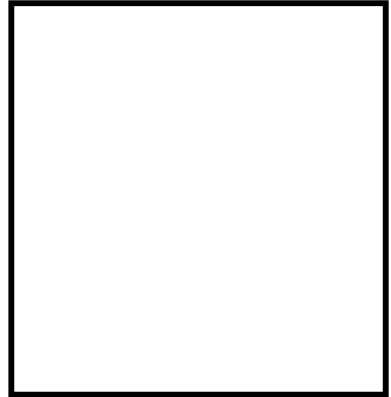
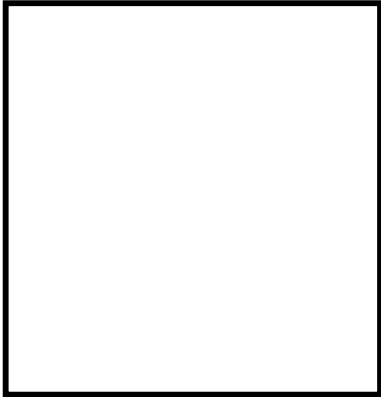
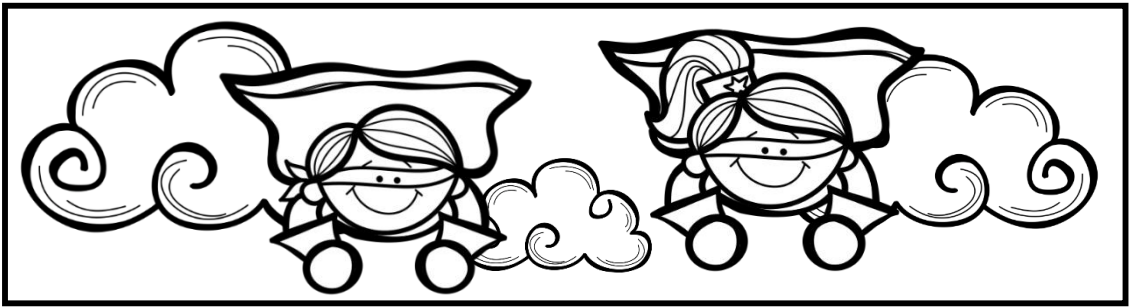
3. Apply glue on the back side above the dotted line & secure on top of indicated markers on base page.



"My Super Words" Base Page - with flaps

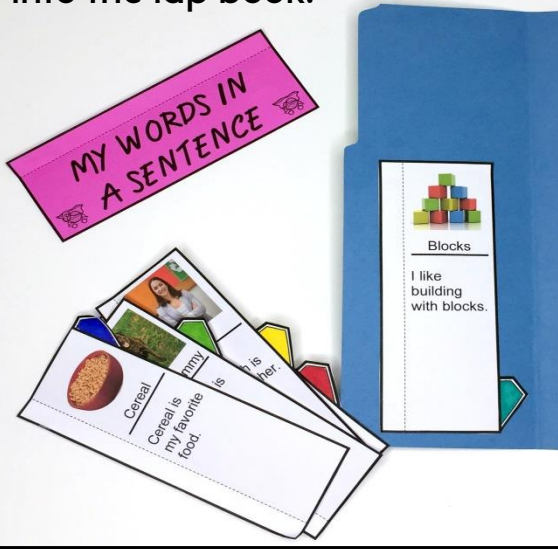


"My Super Words" Base Page - no flaps





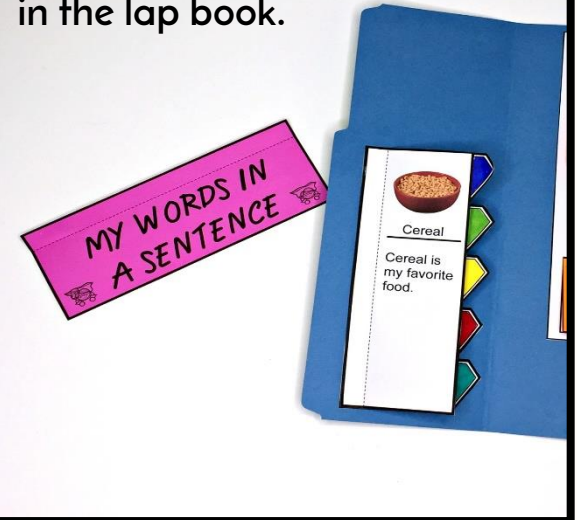
Cut out pages & glue page 1 into the lap book.

Continue layering one on top of the other until all pages are in the lap book.



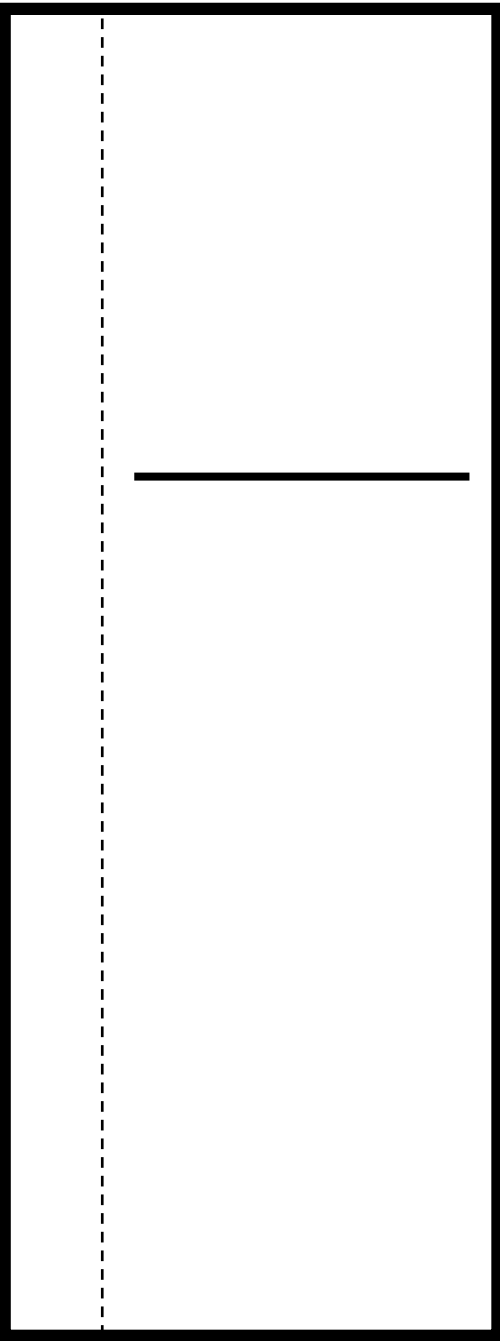

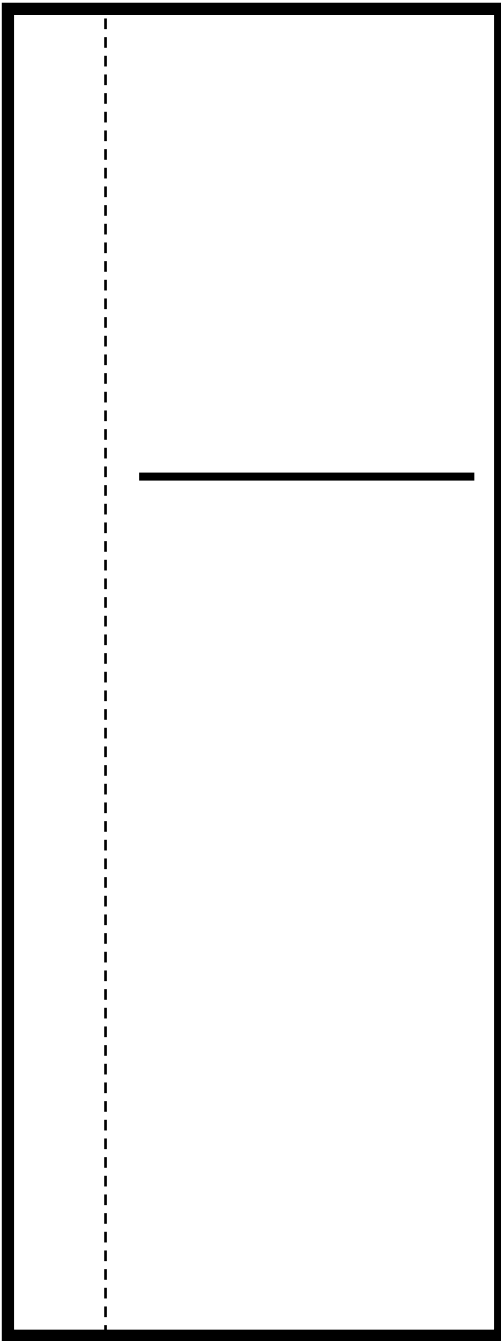

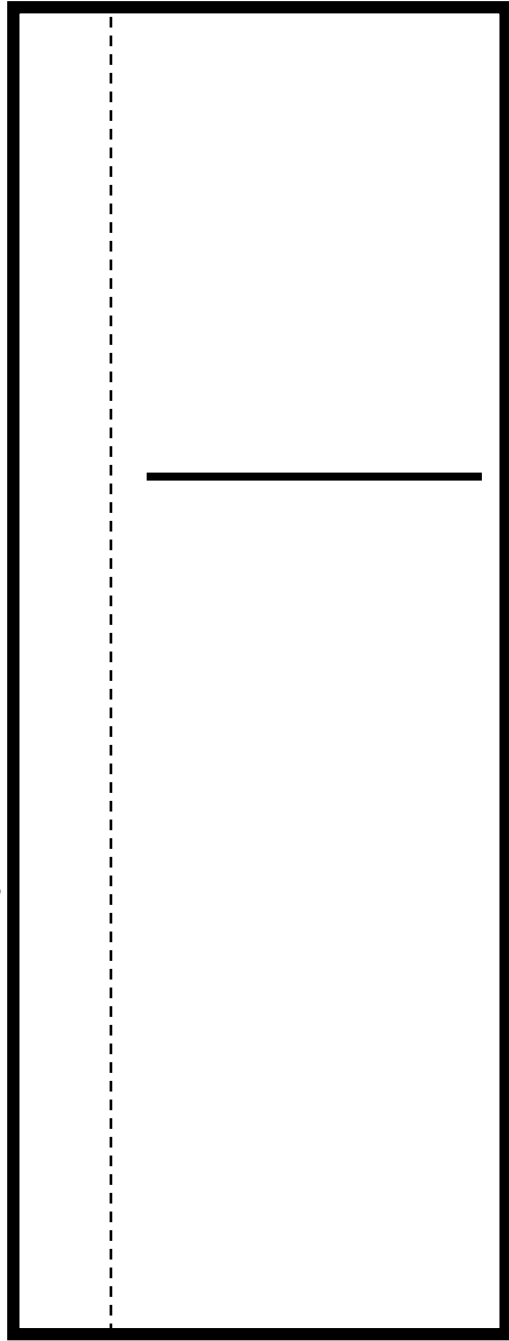
This activity also works great as a take-home review flipbook. Print the pages on durable cardstock and cut. Align the straight edges together & staple to create your booklet.

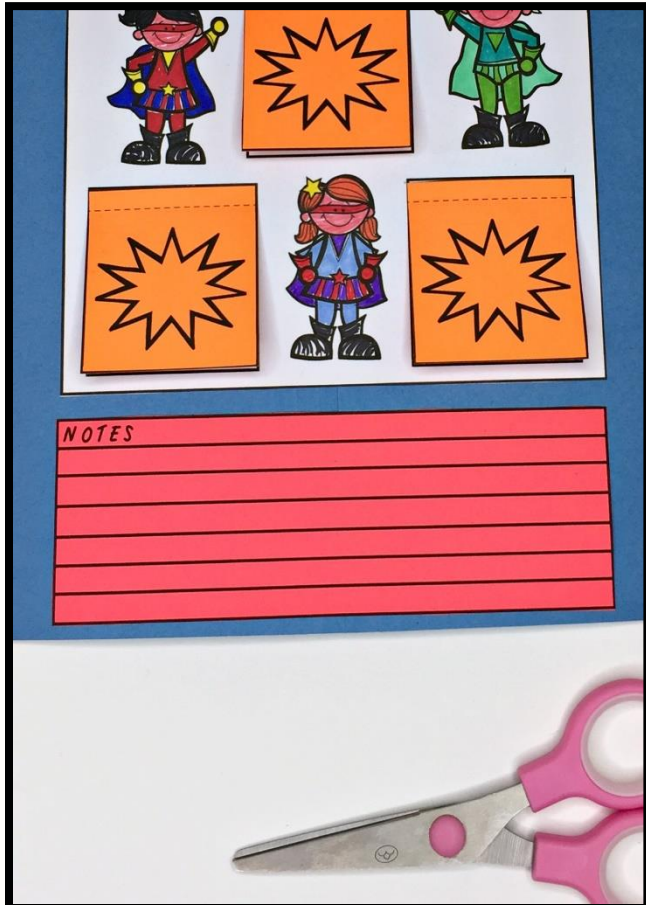
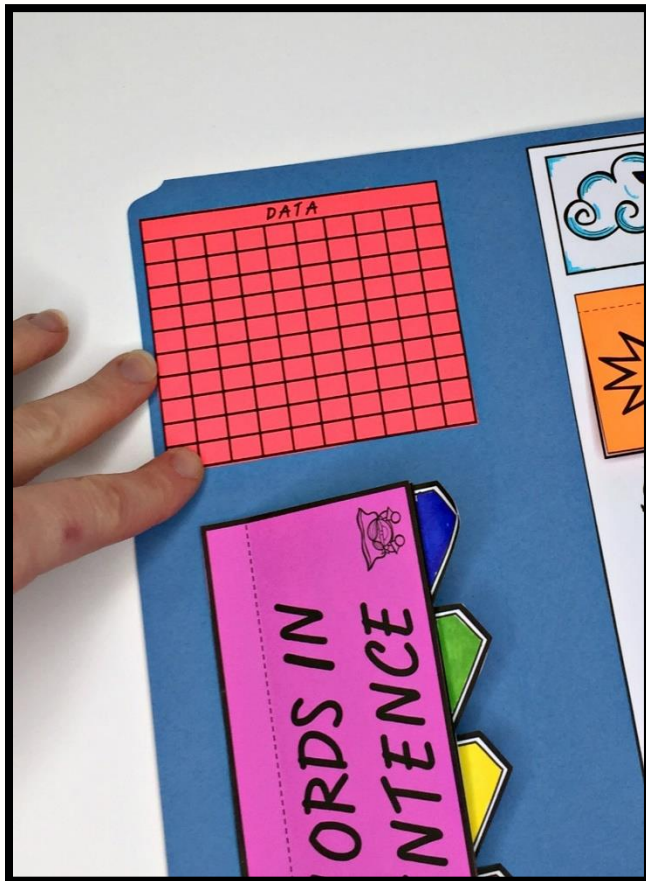
