Using the two copies of your articulation cards play a matching pairs game.


Lay all of the cards facedown in front of your child, and have them say the target word each time they flip a card. Once all of the pairs have been discovered, they WIN!

Activity # 2


Allow your child to color their game board.


Lay all of the cards facedown in front of your child. Have your child flip the cards one at a time reciting each target word as they go. When they say the word correctly they cover the correct space on the board.


You can use small tokens, cereal, candies, or even a bingo dauber to mark off the spaces on the board.





