
- Print two sets of cards, have your students play a matching pairs game. When they successfully match two words they should verbally make a sentence containing that word before moving on to the next player.
- Use the cards as writing prompts to help younger students write the words into a vocabulary notebook. Have them draw a picture of each word underneath.














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
