


From simple labeling through to multiple meaning words, these activities will keep your students occupied and learning.


Use them to challenge early finishers or send them home for extra practice.






On the following pages you will find 12 Spring themed word cards. They are useful for quick and easy vocabulary games and activities when you have a few moments to fill.


Here are some ideas for using them. I'm sure you will think of many more!


• Print two sets of cards, have your students play a matching pairs game. When they successfully match two words they should verbally make a sentence containing that word before moving on to the next player.


• Use the cards as writing prompts to help younger students write the words into a vocabulary notebook. Have them draw a picture of each word underneath.
































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
