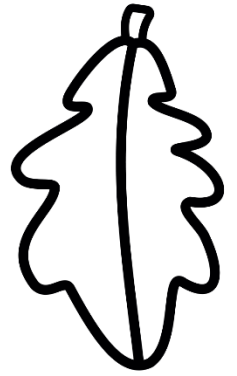
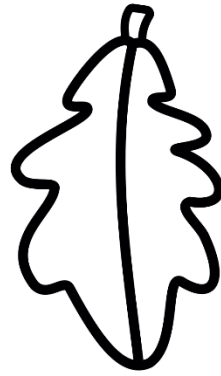
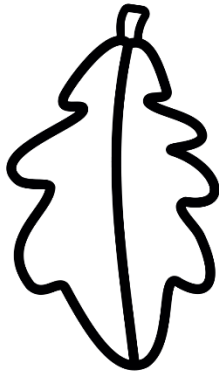
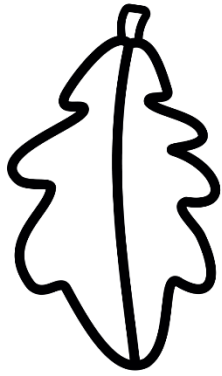
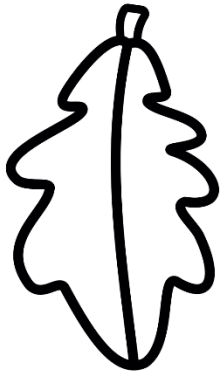




The templates in this section are sized to neatly house 5 mini-images under each flap. Use them as revision activities to cover all of the sounds you've been working on.
