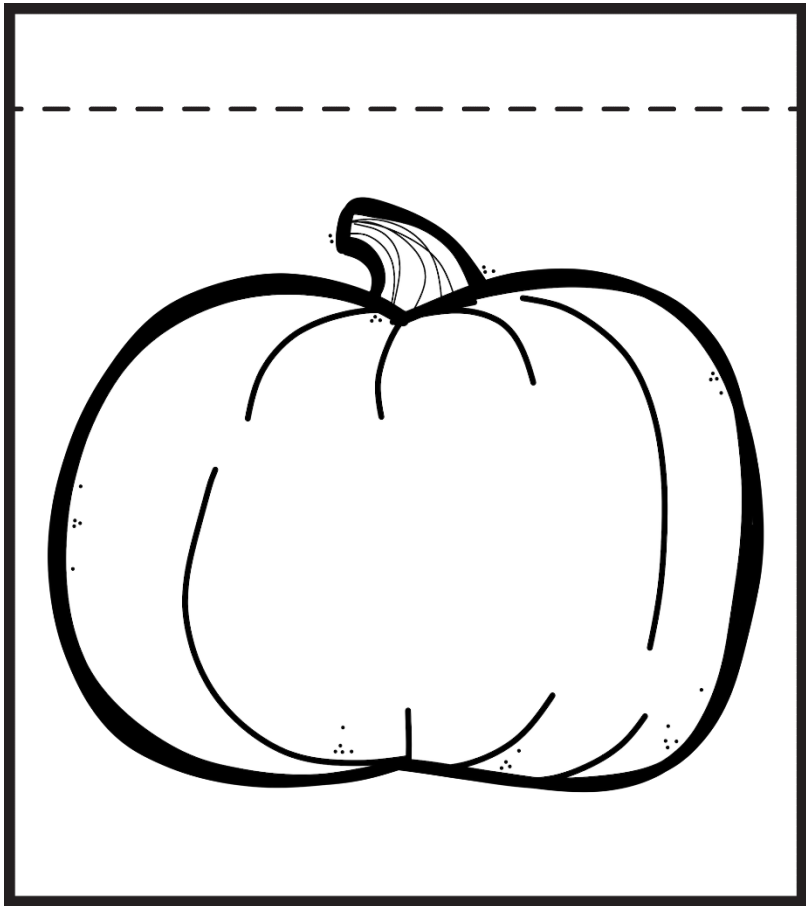
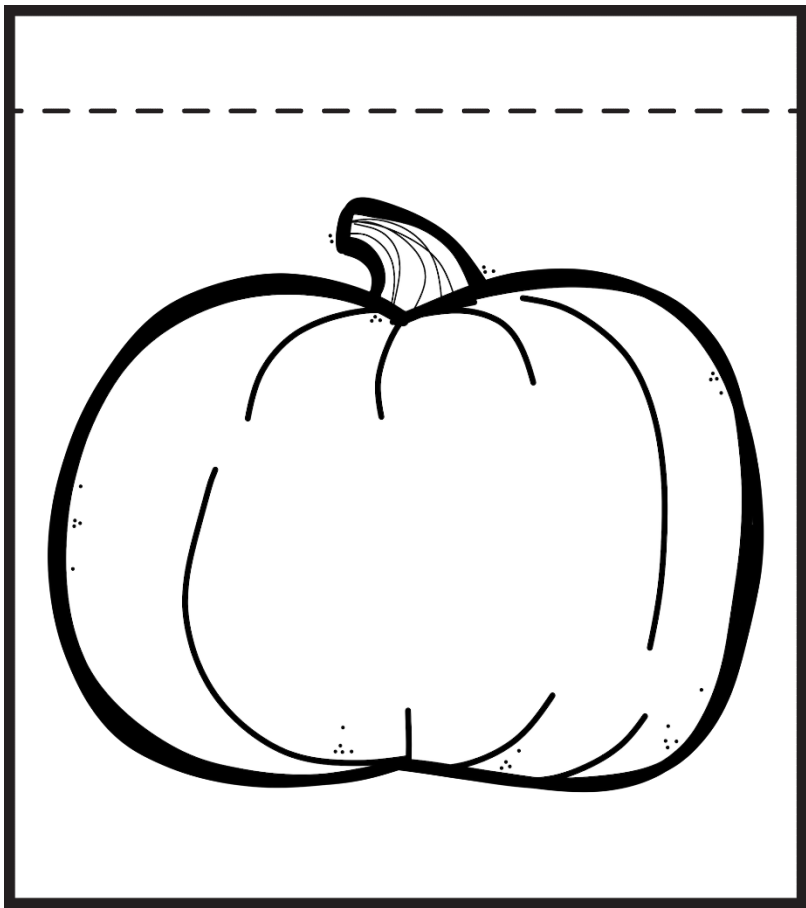








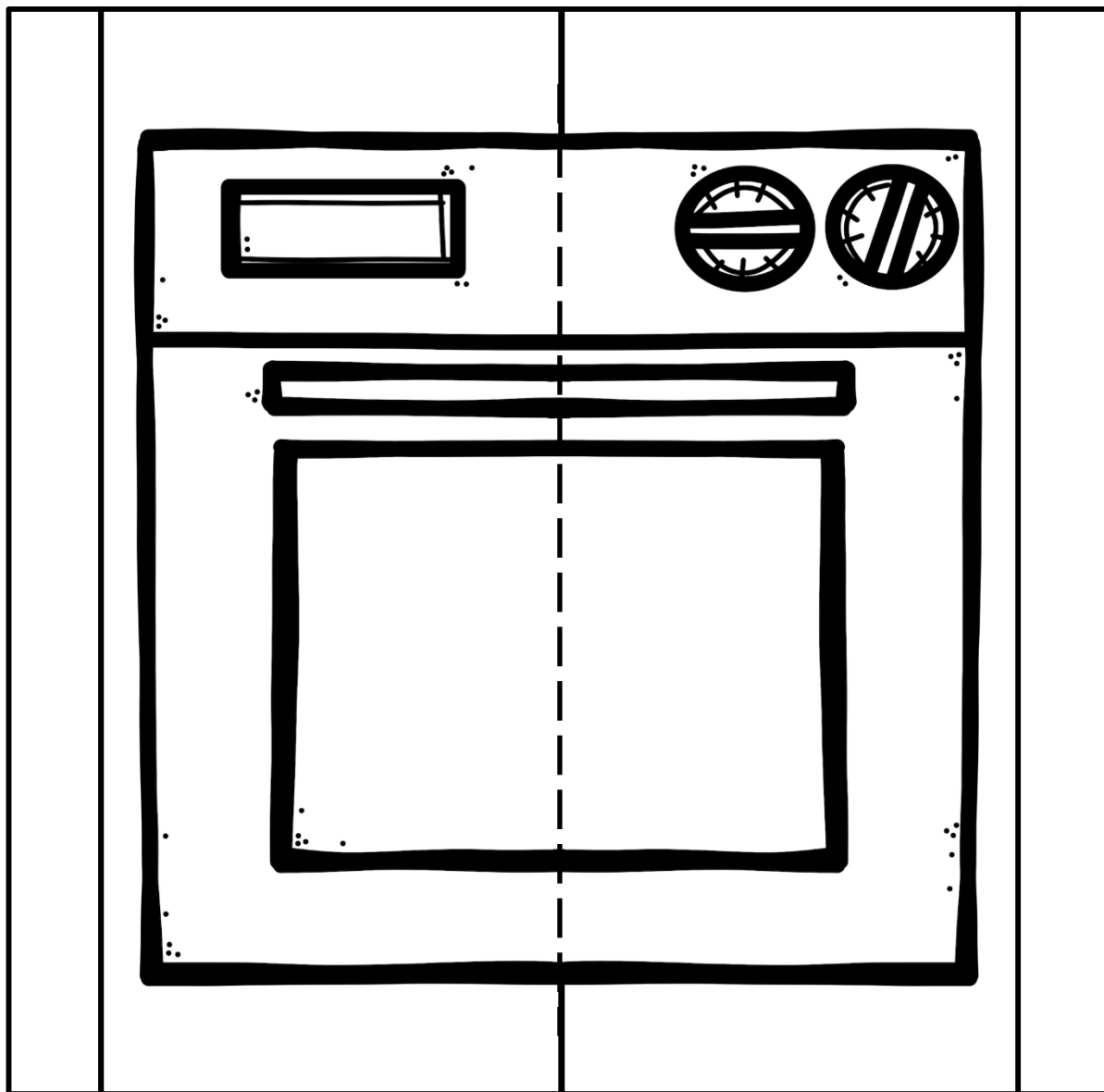




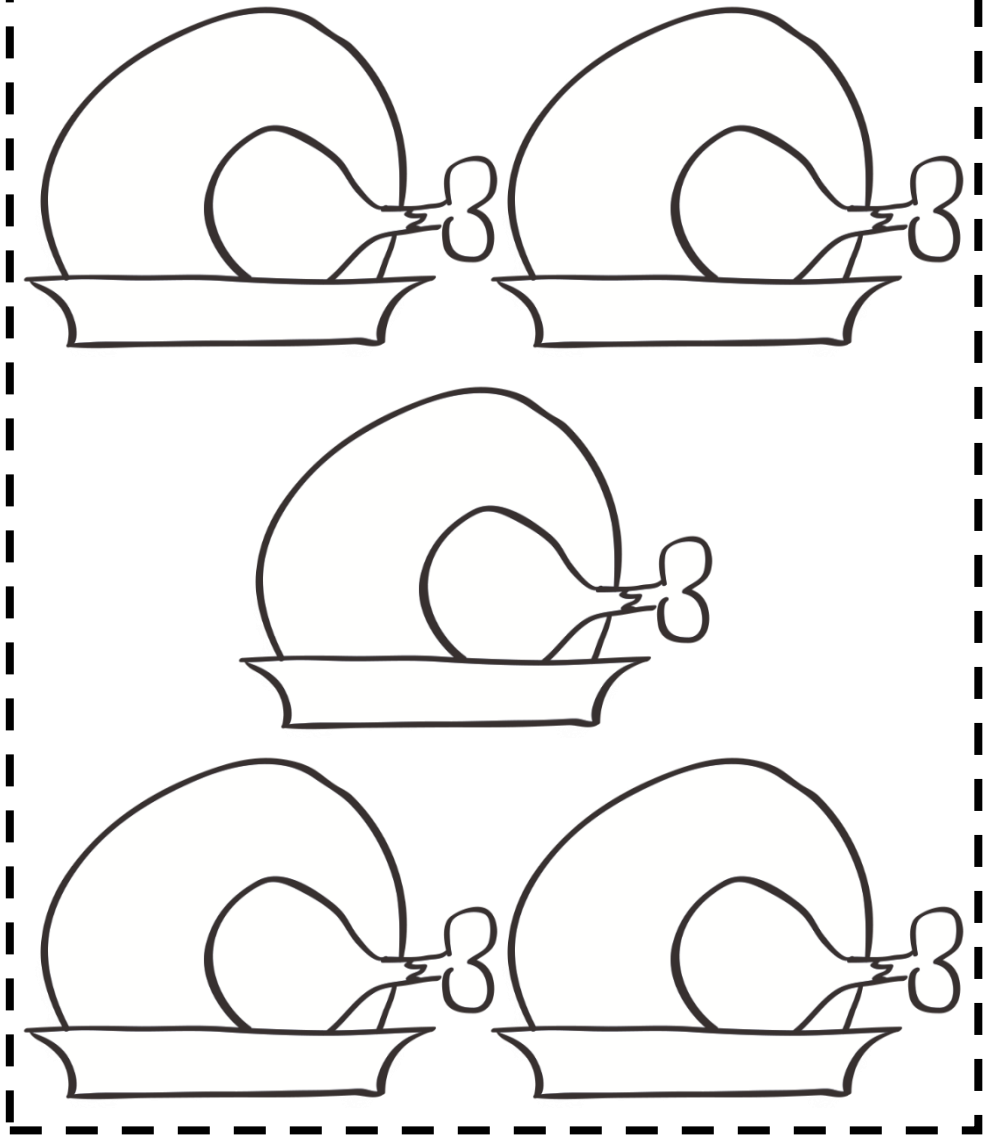
In this section you will find “double - door” flap templates. Make the cut up through the center of the image last, after it has been stuck into the notebook.



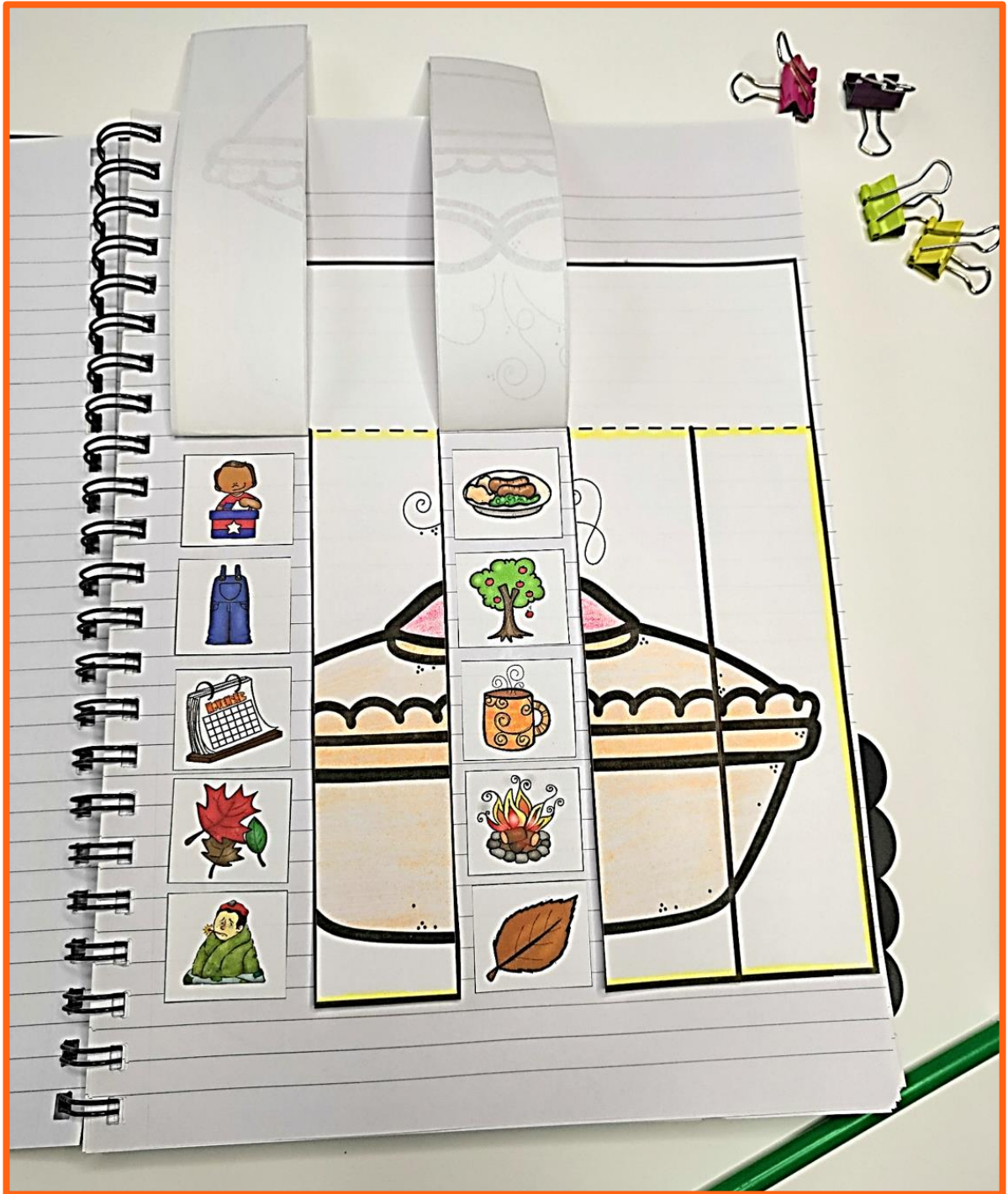

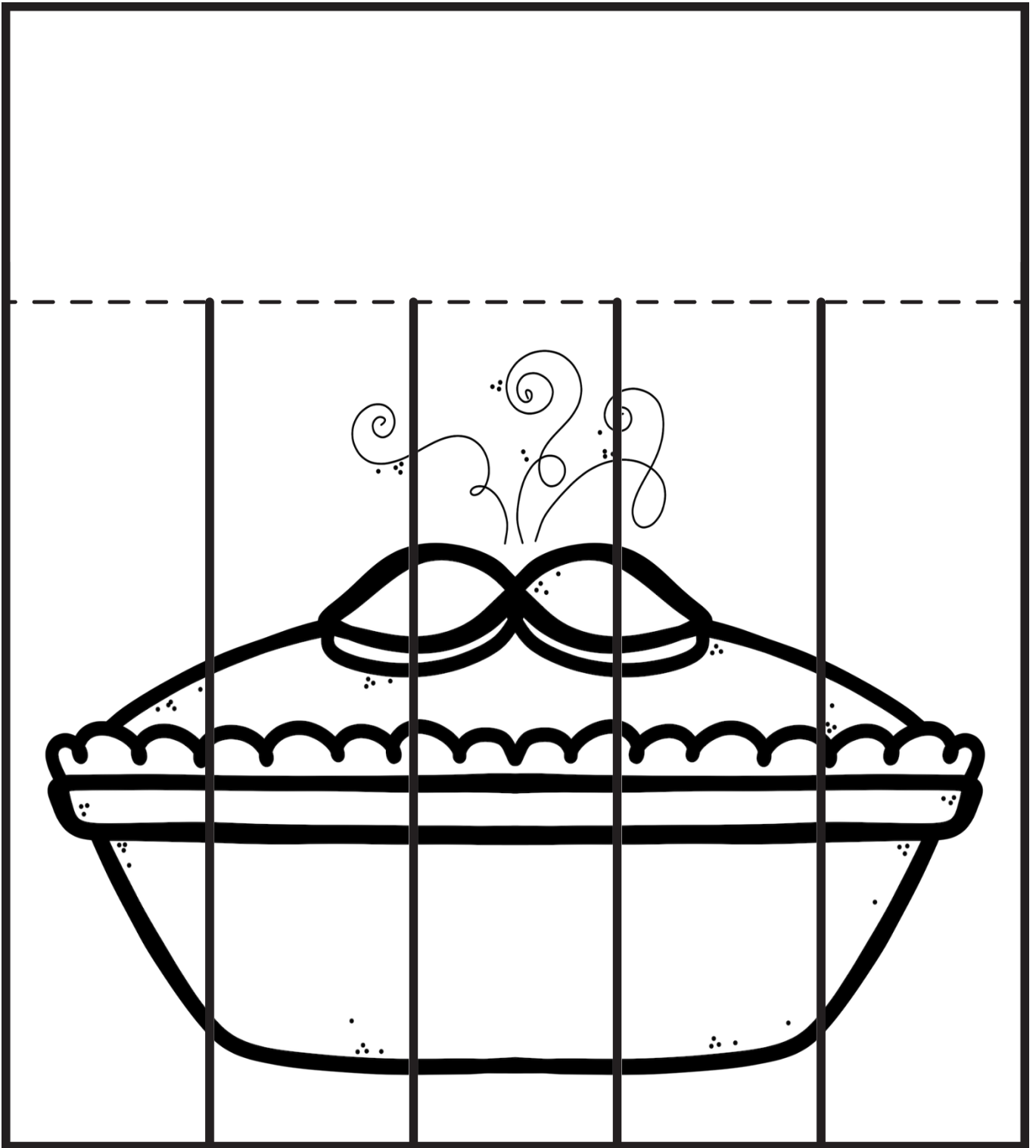


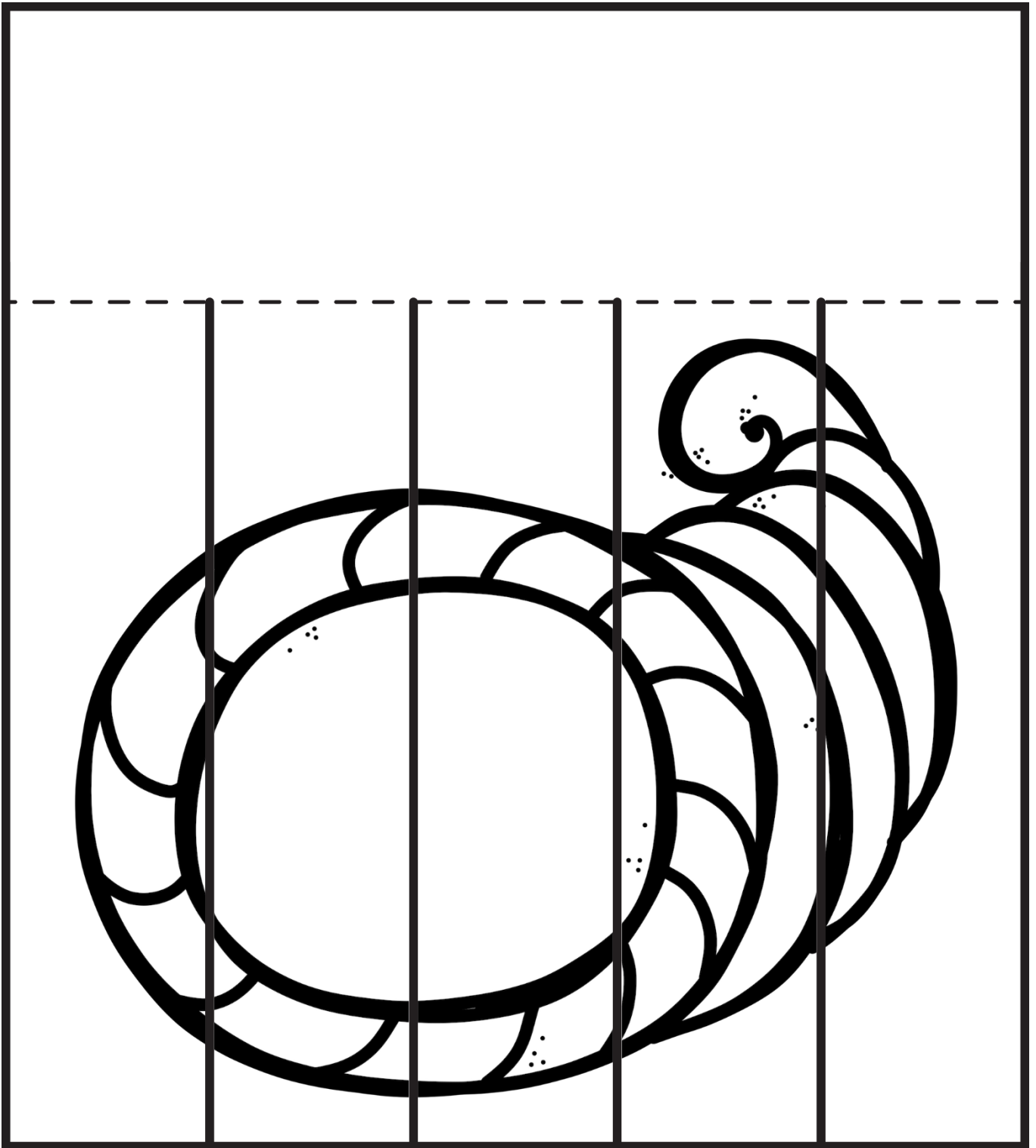
