## Activity Assembly Instructions

- Take time to familiarize yourself with the materials contained in the pack. You may with to print only certain pages or to print some pages in color and others in black and white.
- I prefer to print the baseboards, the cut-out characters and the picture cue cards in color. Then I laminate the pages to help them withstand daily clinic use.
- I then print black and white copies of the pages along with the instruction sheets for parents as needed.
- You can cut out the characters in each pack directly on the lines or make it easier by leaving some white border around each picture.
- The activities work well as "cookie sheet" games. To use them like this, place the baseboards on cookie sheets and use sticky back magnets on the back of the cut outs. This way they will stick to the baseboard.

Sheets of magnets are cheaply available in Walmart or on Amazon – they are often used for the back of business cards. Only a small piece is needed for each one. I used one A4 sheet of magnetic discs to make all 8 packs.
