

Sorting Nouns

Goal: Categorizes nouns by use or function.

Materials:

- *Category Sort* cards (32 cards)
- *Category Sort* baseboard

Activity Instructions:

- Take the baseboard and place on the table in front of your child. Shuffle the noun cards and place in a stack close by.
- Ask your child to draw a card and decide together which category it belongs to. Place the card in the correct spot on the board.
- As your child understands the task, let them continue until they are able to sort all the cards correctly without help.

Example



You say, "Here is a **coat**. Where does it belong?"

Your child should take the picture of the coat and place it in the clothes section.



Hint: If this task is challenging for your child, reduce the difficulty by using just 2 categories of nouns to begin with.
