

# Using Noun + is + Adjective Phrases

**Goal:** Uses auxiliary ( is) + adjective in a phrase.

**Materials:**

- Color Sort cards (32 cards)
- Color Sort baseboard

## Activity Instructions:

- Take the baseboard and place on the table in front of your child. Shuffle the noun cards and place in a stack close by.
- Ask your child to draw a card and decide together which color it belongs to. Place the card in the correct spot on the board.
- As your child understands the task, ask them to tell you why they placed the card in that spot. Prompt them to use a sentence.

## Example



You say, "That 's right, it belongs there. Why does it go there?"

Your child says, "**The dress is red**".



**Hint:** Decide with your SLP on an acceptable sentence structure for your child. E.g. children working at an early level may say "**dress red**" and later you may wish to target "**Because the dress is red**".
