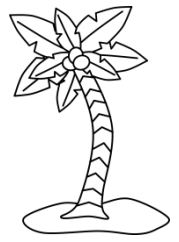




Activities to Target Verb Tense



It is easy to target verb tenses in conjunction with the craftivity.

Future tense

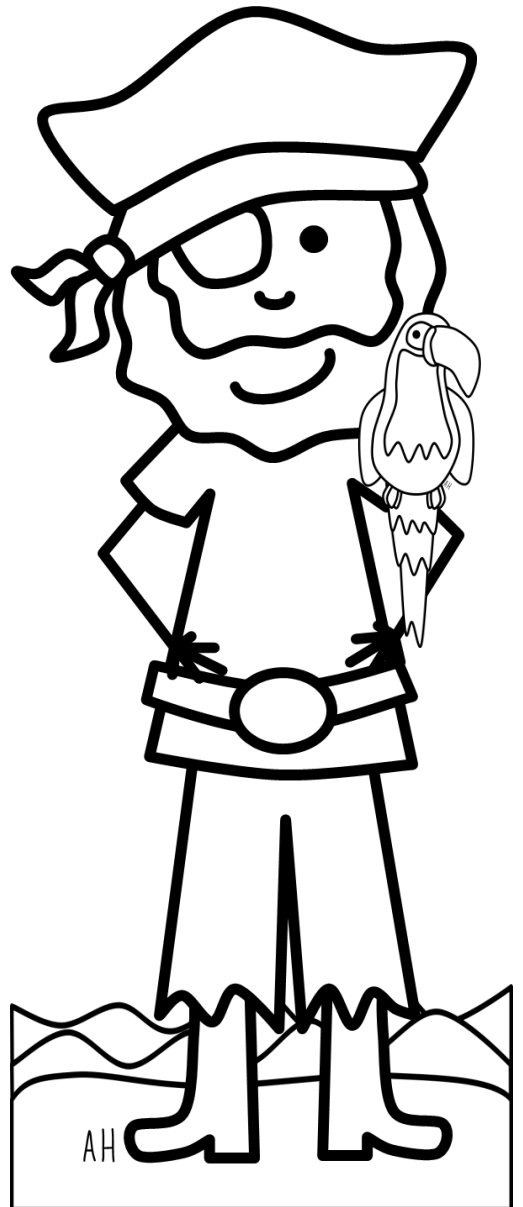
Teacher Instruction: “Pretend you are going to make another of these items tomorrow. Tell me what you will do to make your craft.”







Student: “First I will gather my materials, then I will draw around the templates...” etc.
