


Vocabulary Activities




On the following pages you will find materials for students who are working on vocabulary as part of their language goals.


The materials are flexible to meet a range of needs but the following are suggestions you may wish to try:


- Print the vocabulary cards for the materials and carry out picture to object matching with students who need work at this simple level. Verbally label the items as they match.
- 2) Use the verb cards in a simple game of charades. Have students act out and guess the actions that they will be doing as part of the craftivity (e.g. cut, draw around)
- 3) Have students match cards with the correct noun and verb and make a sentence e.g. "I stick using the glue."
- 4) Keep the cards to hand as visual prompts when students are carrying out the activity. Use them to remind your student which item to use next.
