

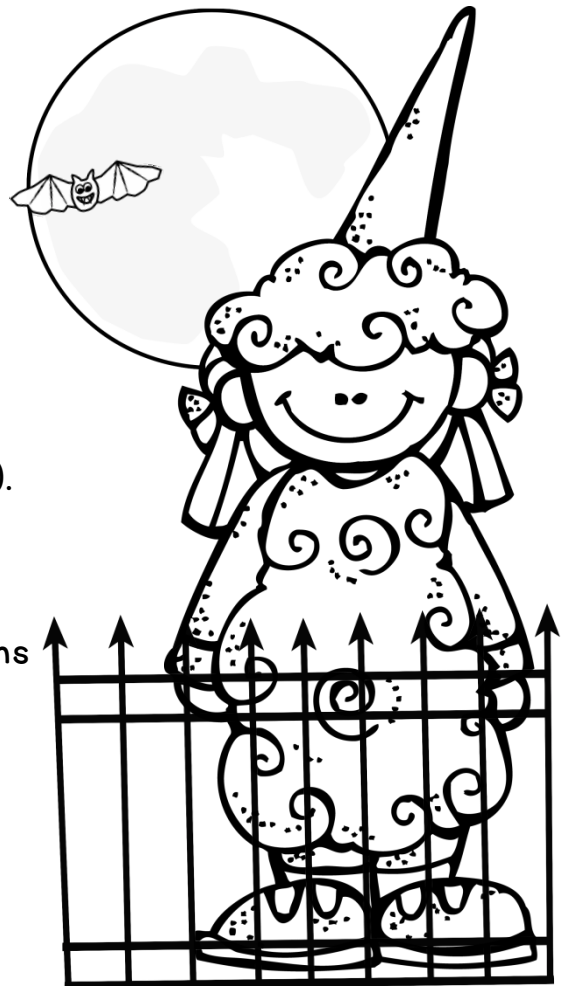
Instructions for Teachers & SLPs

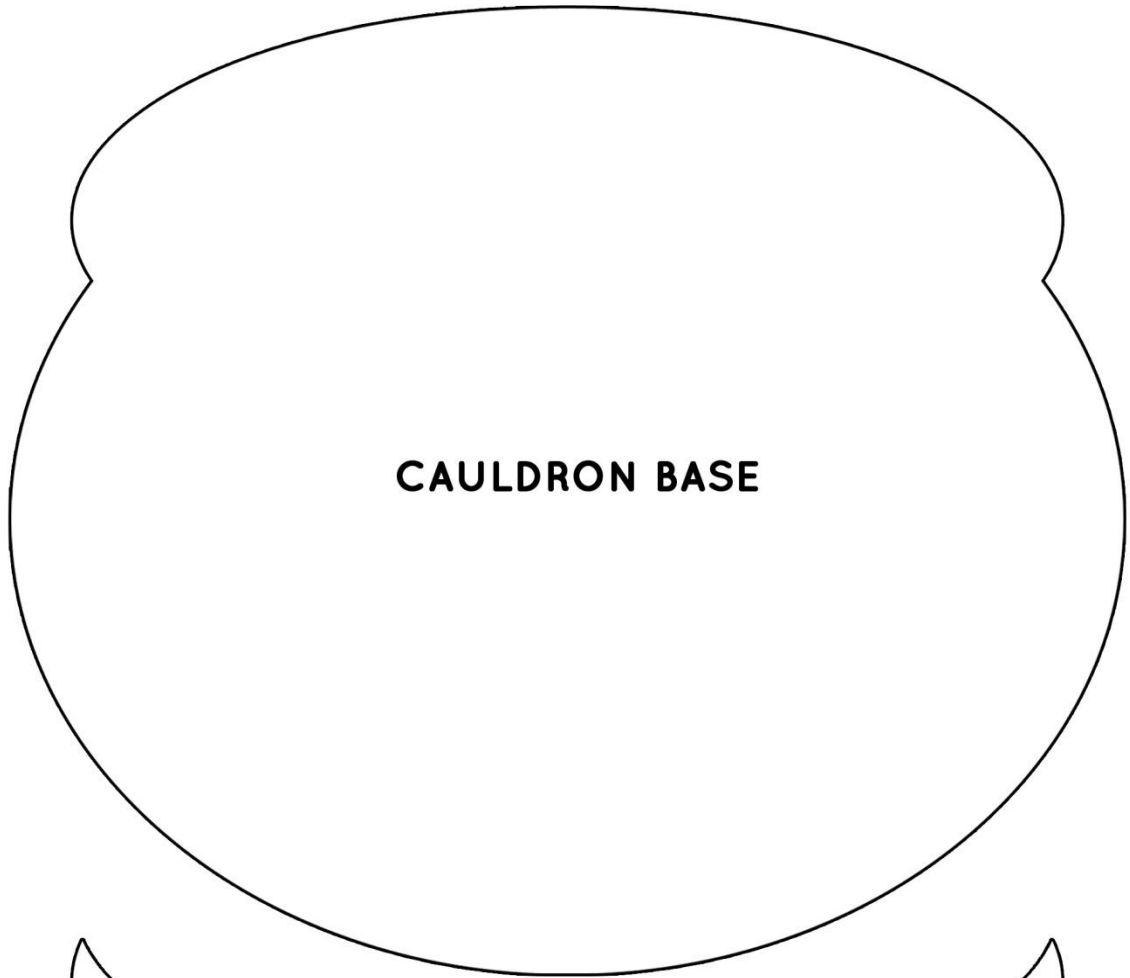


The following instructions are guidelines only. I have deliberately made the craft suitable for students of a wide range of ages and abilities.

Please use your own judgment in deciding how much of the craftivity your own students can complete independently and how much you wish to pre-prepare for them. As a general guideline you should:

- 1) Print the template pages onto cardstock. Use the thickest card that your printer can safely handle to ensure the templates are sturdy.
- 2) Cut out the template pieces (make multiple sets if you have a larger group).
- 3) Prepare the materials. All my craftivities use everyday classroom items that you already have in your room or that can be obtained cheaply from a craft or school supplies store.





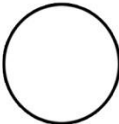
CAULDRON BASE



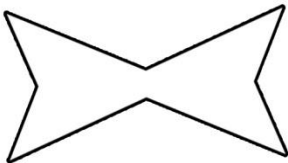
CAULDRON TOP

to be placed at top of BASE

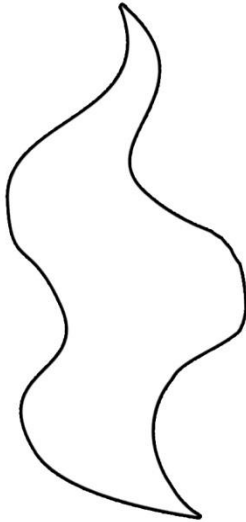
CANDY 1 TOP



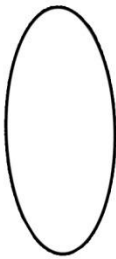
CANDY 1 BASE



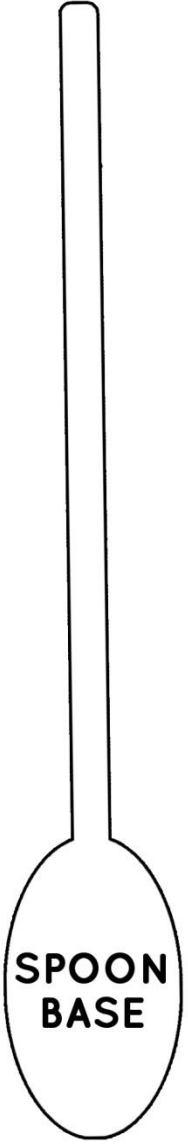
**CUT SEVERAL

FLAMES**



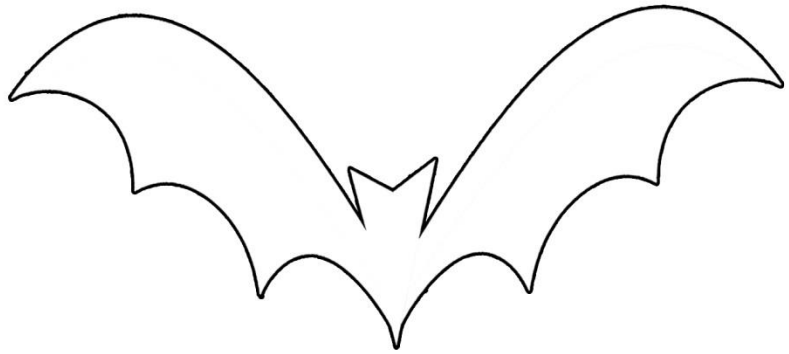

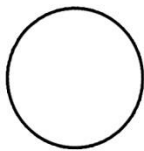
SPOON TOP



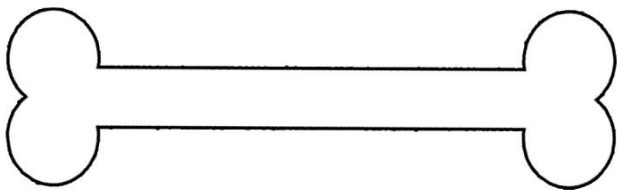
BAT



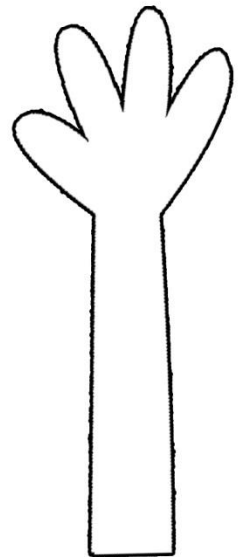
EYE BASE
